The Child with Severe Asthma

People who are desperate on account of a child with severe asthma might well find great help in the Jewish National Home for Asthmatic Children (3447 W. 19th a.v., Denver 4, Colo.). This fine hospital and research institute accepts for treatment children of all faiths. These severely asthmatic children always have some deformity of the chest; some have emphysema (in which the little lung cells are dilated or ruptured one into the other); some are highly allergic; some are neurotic; and most are undersized and underweight.

Sew It in a Day

It is a remarkable and significant fact that, often, the day the child arrives in the hospital, he stops wheezing. There can be several reasons for this, but often the main one is that the child came from a home in which the parents had become so anxious and nervous and fussy over their sick child that their anxiety reacted back onto him. Perhaps they upset him badly by keeping him always under a microscope.

As one would expect, in some of these cases, after six months of good health in the hospital, when the mother comes to visit the child or to take him home, he starts wheezing again, with a flare-up of his asthma. And yet, the experts in this hospital feel that asthma is not primarily a psychic disease; it is only made worse by mental strain. Primarily there is an inherited predisposition to spasms in the tubes that lead into the lungs. Usually, also, there is an inherited hypersensitiveness to dusts and pollens and molds of various kinds. Many children get a bad attack of wheezing whenever they get a cold. Hence it is that an asthmatic child should be treated by a doctor with a wide training. Oftentimes it helps tremendously to get the child out of a certain environment where he is constantly getting hay fever and asthma. Often a severe hay fever leads into asthma. It is very important to help an asthmatic child quickly, because if he remains asthmatic for many years, he is likely to get into a state from which it is almost impossible to rescue him; too many permanent changes will have taken place in his lungs, and his body.

Wall Street Chatter
New York—(UPI)—With inventory building proving a less potent stimulus than had been hoped, sights are being lowered on the extent of the 1960 business advance, reports the Value Line Investment Survey.

"Now that the shortages of late 1959 have been corrected, consumers are showing no eagerness to buy, nor businessmen to stock goods."

Value Line believes a more modest rate of increase, governed by the "consumption economy, thus seems in store for business this year." Even in the important area of capital spending, it adds, there appears to be no rise of boom proportions under way.

"To some extent, this caution may be traced to the steep stock market decline of the past month, and its effect on businessmen's confidence—which, after all, is the controlling factor determining the pace of the economy."

Walter G. Bernthal of Filor, Bullard & Smyth would not be surprised if present margin regulations were modified to give the market more liquidity.

Once a decline in steel output has gotten under way, it usually moves fast, Schroeder Boulton of Goodbody & Co., notes. From the standpoint of the investor, perhaps, the sooner the industry gets down to shipping only at the level of consumption the better, he adds.
