**Dominican 'Thugs'
Flee To Embassy**

Ciudad Trujillo, D. R. - (AP) - Motorized "gangsters" shot and killed a man in the streets here Wednesday, wounded two policemen and fled to the Brazilian Embassy, the government announced Wednesday night.
The foreign ministry statement identified neither the "gangsters" nor the man they killed. Police said a check of license numbers showed that one of the cars used by the gunmen is registered in the name of Mario Read Vitini, but it was not certain whether he was involved.
CBS correspondent Bill Leonard, who was in effect ousted from the Dominican Republic Wednesday, said in Puerto Rico that 17 students fearing imprisonment or death sought asylum in the Brazilian Embassy after a gunfight with Dominican guards.
