Four More Drives On in Oregon for Position on Ballot

Salem—At least four drives are on in Oregon to put names by petition on the state presidential primary ballot May 20.

The first petitions, assuring Sen. Wayne Morse (D-Ore.) a spot in the primary, were filed last week by E. G. Neal of Salem.

Petitions also are being passed around by Sens. John F. Kennedy (D-Mass.), Hubert Humphrey (D-Minn.), Vice President Richard Nixon and Adlai Stevenson.

The first three at least will be on the state ballot anyway, put there by Secretary of State Howell Appling Jr.

Campaign Paced
Kennedy's state headquarters in Portland is pacing his petition campaign and the Humphrey petitions are being circulated by his state campaigners led by Oregon Labor Commissioner Norman Nilsen.

The Nixon drive is headed by Wendell Wyatt, Astoria attorney.

A trio of young Democrats in Portland indicated earlier they have the necessary 1,000 signatures to enter Stevenson but haven't decided for sure whether to do it.

Stevenson has said right along he doesn't want his name on the ballot.

Decision on March 11
According to law, Appling will make known those whom he has selected to be presidential and vice presidential candidates in Oregon on March 11, at 5 p.m.

Since he selects them on the basis of "general advocacy in national news media," the Democratic slate is expected to be lopsided compared with the Republicans. Of the presidency alone, although Kennedy, Humphrey and Morse are the only active campaigners in Oregon, Senate Majority Leader Lyndon Johnson, Sen. Stuart Symington (D-Mo.) and others could and no doubt will be tagged for the ballot without even setting foot in the state.

Halleck Seeks Bid
There is a good chance that there won't be any vice presidential candidates on the Oregon ballot.

The only person so far who has indicated publicly he is after a Veep bid is House Minority Leader Richard Halleck (R-Ind.). And Appling will have to decide whether Halleck is nationally advocated.

"It seems questionable," Appling says, "whether anyone at this time is really advocated through the nation for vice president, in either party."

Nixon, of course, will be put on the Republican ballot by Appling and the Secretary of State has indicated he may include Gov. Nelson Rockefeller of New York, too, despite the latter's statement withdrawing from the race.

Appling has pointed out that personal intentions have nothing to do with it; it's only "general advocacy" that counts.

A spokesman for Rockefeller told United Press International in Albany, N.Y., that since it's an "if" situation, Rockefeller will cross the
