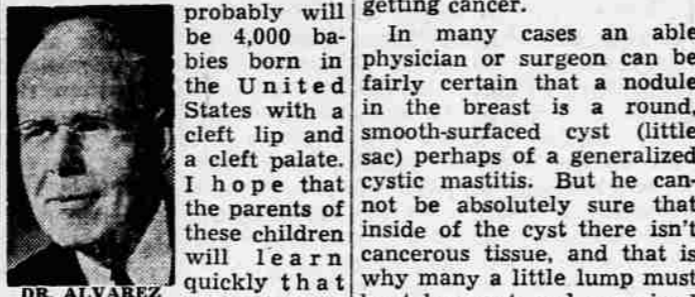

The Medical Roundup

Child With Cleft Palate or Hare Lip
The National Society for Crippled Children and Adults, Inc., tells that in 1960 there probably will be 4,000 babies born in the United States with a cleft lip and a cleft palate. I hope that the parents of these children will learn quickly that even if their income is small they can get the defect repaired by an expert plastic surgeon, perhaps working with a dental surgeon. Later, the child may have to be helped by a speech therapist. Today, many of our schools employ such persons. In every city of any size there are surgeons who do a magnificent job of repairing the defects in the children.



Parents who do not know which way to turn for help might write to Miss Catharine Bauer, of the National Society for Crippled Children and Adults, 2033 W. Ogden ave., Chicago, Ill. They might also send 25 cents to her (do not send it to me) for a booklet written by Dr. E. T. McDonald for their help. The doctor points out that the parents must not feel guilty in any way; they are not at fault. In the first weeks of an infant's life (in the womb) the face grows from the two sides. Normally, these two halves meet in the middle and fuse, but in a rare child, the fusion is not perfect. Many parents will be cheered to read that a cleft palate does not make the child less intelligent. I know a number of able physicians who, in infancy, had a cleft palate.

New York - (UPI) - The Institute of Life Insurance said today that Oregon families received \$25,891,000 during 1959 in death benefits from life insurance companies. The payments were made under 10,111 policies. New York led the states in the total of death benefit payments in 1959 with \$441,670,000, the Institute said.
