NATIONAL FOREST TIMBER

Red Blanket Salvage
Oral auction bids will be received by the Forest Supervisor, or his authorized representative at the office of the Forest Supervisor, Post Office Building, Medford, Oregon, beginning at 2:00 p.m., April 4, 1960, for all merchantable timber marked or designated for cutting on an area embracing 3,500 acres, more or less, within Sections 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, and 23, T. 32 S. R. 4 E. W.M., surveyed in the Rogue River National Forest, Jackson County, Oregon. The estimated volumes are: 3,500 M board feet of Douglas-fir, 1,100 M board feet of white fir and other species. The minimum acceptable bid per M board feet is as follows: Douglas-fir \$22.40, white fir and other species \$8.65. This includes the following rates, per M board feet for stumpage (including deposits for sale area betterment): Douglas-fir \$22.40, white fir and other species \$8.65, and \$0.00 for slash disposal for all species. In addition there is within the sale area an unestimated volume of Douglas-fir logs and peeler blocks unmerchantable because of defect which the bidder may agree to remove at \$2.00 per M board feet gross scale for stumpage only. Sealed bids will be publicly opened and posted at the office of the Forest Supervisor, at 2:00 p.m., April 4, 1960. All those who submitted a satisfactory sealed bid will be permitted immediately to continue auction bidding. A money order, bank draft, cashier's or certified check in the sum of \$4,900.00 must accompany each bid, to be applied to the purchase price, refunded, or retained for application to any claim for damages, according to the conditions of sale. If requested by the purchaser, contract terms will permit felling of timber in advance of payment up to the value of the performance bond. If an oral bid is declared to be high at the closing of the auction, the bidder must immediately confirm the oral bid by submitting it in writing on a Forest Service bid form. The right to reject any and all bids is reserved. Forest Service bid forms for use in submitting sealed bids and full information concerning the timber, the conditions of sale and the submission of bids should be obtained from the District Ranger, Prospect, Oregon, or the Forest Supervisor, Medford, Oregon, before bids are submitted.
