**RESOLUTION NO. 10112**

A RESOLUTION declaring intention of the City Council to construct a water main along McAndrews Road, formerly Buckshot Road, from Waverly Avenue to a point 468 feet West of Springbrook Road in the City of Medford, Oregon, and to assess the cost thereof against properties fronting thereon and setting time and place for hearing thereon.

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Medford, Oregon:

SECTION 1. That it is the intention of the City Council of the said city to cause an eight (8) inch water main to be laid in McAndrews Road, formerly Buckshot Road, from Waverly Avenue to a point 468 feet West of Springbrook Road in the City of Medford, Oregon, and to assess the cost of said water main on the property fronting on said street (s) in proportion to the frontage of said property.

SECTION 2. That the City Council shall meet in the Council Chambers of the City Hall of said city at 7:30 o'clock P.M. on the 17th day of March, 1960, at which time and place all protests against the laying of said water main and the assessment of the cost thereof on the property fronting on said street (s) shall be heard, and the City Council is hereby directed to cause this Resolution to be published once in a daily newspaper, published and of general circulation in the said city of Medford, not less than ten days or more than twenty days before the date of said meeting and a copy of this Resolution to be read at said meeting in five public and conspicuous places in the said city.

SECTION 3. That warrants for the costs of the aforementioned improvement shall bear interest at 4% per annum and shall constitute General Obligations of the City of Medford, and said warrants shall be issued pursuant to, and on the terms and conditions set forth in, ORS 260-200 to 267, inclusive.

**The Dalles Project Favored by Board**

Salem - (UP) - The Oregon Resources Board has gone on record favoring the Dalles federal irrigation project.

The board Saturday recommended a plan calling for use of Columbia river water to irrigate about 5,400 acres of land, mostly cherry orchards, in The Dalles area, which has been designated a "critical" water area by the state.

At present only ground water supplies the area for irrigation purposes. The board recommended the federal plan with the suggestion that it be tied to a specific project, such as The Dalles dam.
