Back Stairs: A Career in Teaching

Washington - (UPI) - Back stairs at the White House:

Friends of Maj. John Eisenhower, the President's son, say he has been talking about a career in teaching after his father leaves office next January. John and his wife, Barbara, like the kind of life they have now in Gettysburg, even with John commuting back and forth to his job in the White House.

John, modest, almost retiring young man of 36, truly is pained by the limelight into which he has been pushed as

the son of the chief executive. He looks forward to the day when his children will not have to be guarded constantly as they are now.

Agent Stands By
Last week end at Ramey Air Force Base in Puerto Rico, David Eisenhower, 11-year-old grandson of the President, wanted to go outside his grandfather's quarters and practice basketball shots alone.

It made sort of a sad picture - David determinedly shooting basket after basket and, standing unobtrusively in the tropical shrubbery, a Secret

Service agent in a tweed suit.

Coin Souvenir
Prize souvenir of the President's South American trip - a coin on which Eisenhower expressed his appreciation for assistance during the journey.

The coins were passed out by the hundred to American Embassy employees and working officials of host countries.

One of Eisenhower's top assistants says of his South American trip:

"There's no doubt about it - we overplanned this one. We wrote schedules that were so detailed and so closely

timed that sometimes keeping the schedule became much more important than the purpose of the trip, to spread good will."

To which most of the reporters who made the trip would add a hearty amen.

Known as Bible

The schedule, a document of some 38 pages, was known in the travel party as "the Bible." At each stop it was supplemented by an even more detailed schedule prepared by the American Embassy and the host government.

One of the schedules prepared locally went so far as to say "there will be no talking while the President moves

from point A to point B."

*Writing such tight and detailed schedules might be fine for a highly trained military force, but it is wasted on South American bus drivers - and sometimes South American presidents who couldn't quite see the point of entering an automobile precisely at 12:31. 30 p.m. (local time, which is eastern standard time plus one hour).

Journey Big Success

Overplanned or not, the people around the President feel that the South American journey, from the standpoint of person-to-person improvement of friendship and understanding between the United States and her southernmost

neighbors was a big success.

Some of the President's advisers feel that he really accomplished more in South America than he did in his 11 nation tour last December. The reason for this feeling in some quarters is that in South America, Eisenhower was up against situations where lack of understanding or anti-Americanism could be dealt with effectively in personal contacts and ceremonial appearances.

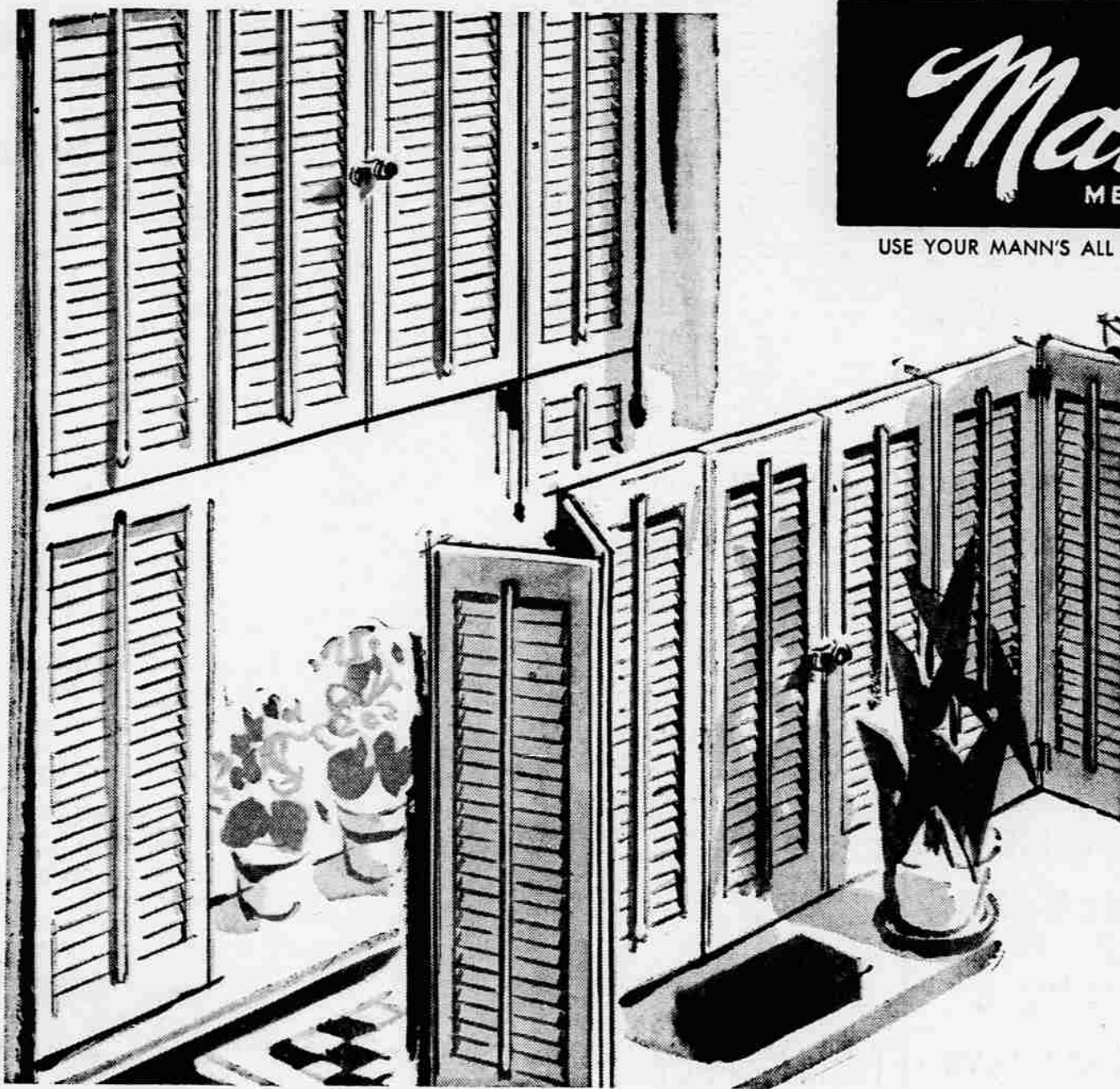
