Roseburg Approves Two School Issues

Roseburg - (UPI) - A school district \$1,135,000 bond issue was voted in here Wednesday by a 99 vote margin. The vote was 1,764 yes, and 1,865 against.

A second issue involved use of \$200,000 received from the sale of the damaged junior school. Voters consented to a building program with the money by a vote of 2,069 for and 1,276 against.

The alternative would have been to use the money for general funds. The school was heavily damaged in the truck explosion last August.
