

Ranchers' Water Outlook Better

Hermiston—Farmers and ranchers of Umatilla, Morrow and Gilliam counties can expect better irrigation facilities than last year but still not up to average. That was the forecast Thursday of W. T. Frost, snow survey supervisor for the Soil Conservation Service. He said water supply conditions would continue to improve if above normal snowfall and rain continued this month. Water content of the mountain snow cover, except for the Walla Walla watershed, is 85 per cent of normal and 149 per cent of last year. Snow is 77 per cent of normal on the Walla Walla.

Dog Bites

According to Professor Henry M. Parrish, of Burlington, Vt., the country's experts on bites and stings say that in the U. S. each year somewhere between 600,000 and 1,000,000 people are bitten by dogs. The doctor notes that hound dogs do the least amount of biting, while boxers, collies, Eskimo dogs, German shepherds, great Danes and St. Bernards do much of it.

All people should know that when a dog comes up and bites a child who was not bothering him at all, it is tremendously important that someone keep the dog in sight until the health department can impound him. If they can get the dog, they can usually soon tell whether or not he is rabid. If he is rabid, then the person bitten must be treated with a vaccine. This often is a
