Inherited Diseases Not Necessarily Untreatable

I receive some angry letters from people who are disgusted with me, first because I say that most mental diseases are hereditary, and as a result, the mother and her children are going to suffer from malnutrition. What is happening is that some people are getting so frightened that now they write me they do not dare use my "deep freeze." Actually, I see no reason to be alarmed. I am sure freezing of food is not destroying all our vitamins, and it is not going to injure our health. For many years now, it has been the custom to keep most of our perishable foods in cold storage, and I know of no epidemic due to poor nourishment. People are silly to fall for the argument of a man whose daily bread depends on his selling them something they don't need. He just has to begin by scaring them to death!

Hidden Heart Disease Located With Radioiodine

Los Angeles—(Science Service)—Unsuspected heart disease or suspicious heart disease symptoms may be detected by a relatively simple radioactive technique for measuring the flow of blood in the arteries of the heart muscle.

The technique was developed in the University of California, Los Angeles, Medical Center by Drs. Ismael Mena, Leslie R. Bennett, Mark Winfield and Albert A. Kattus. Compound Injected

A very small amount of radioiodine compound is injected into a vein. Two scintillation counters, one placed over the heart, the other over the brain, follow progress of the compound as it goes to the heart and thence into the arterial system feeding the brain.

The difference in the rate at which the radioactive compound clears the heart and the brain is due to the flow of the compound into the heart blood vessels. In coronary heart disease some blood vessels of the heart are blocked.

Flow Impeded

Thus the flow of the radioactive material into the heart blood vessels is impeded and the more severe the heart disease the less radioactive material that can flow into the heart arteries. In fact the rate of clearance of radioactivity from the heart and brain in heart disease patients is almost identical.

In studies with the new procedure the investigators have been able to detect heart disease in subjects with normal appearing electrocardiograms. In other cases it has helped to confirm other findings symptomatic of heart disease.

Mental Attitude Affects Obesity

Philadelphia (Science Service)—Emotional depression disturbs the normal balance of sugar metabolism in the body, and this, in turn, caused some obese women to overeat, five investigators here have found.

The overeating was not caused by an increase in hunger drive, but by a failure of the brain's signal mechanism to indicate when hunger had been satisfied. Dr. Albert Stunkard, professor of psychiatry at the University of Pennsylvania, reported. The upset in sugar metabolism seemed to interfere with proper stimulation of the brain's mechanism for indicating hunger satisfaction.

Research by the investigators indicates that mental attitudes and reactions play an important role in accelerating or retarding a person's inclination to become excessively overweight.

Assisting Dr. Stunkard are Drs. Anna Marie Chirico and Myer Mendelson, and Charles R. Koch and Mrs. Barbara Martin. The team received a \$140,000 grant from the National Institute of Mental Health, Bethesda, Md.

New York—(UPI)—Patrolman Howard Wolfe was surprised to hear the squeal of rusty wheels on an otherwise quiet downtown street. Tracing the noise to its source, he found—and arrested—five youths wheeling an old safe containing \$5,979 in cash and more than \$15,000 worth of jewelry which had been stolen from a Chinese restaurant.
