

Pilots Will Get Location Device

Washington - (Science Service) - Equipment that will quickly tell a private pilot exactly where he is will soon be available, the Federal Aviation Agency reports.

The lightweight, low-cost equipment will automatically transmit electronic pulses from the plane to the nearest of 250 ground stations (VOR-TAC units). The unmanned station will respond with a signal.

This signal will be translated by the airborne device to give the pilot his distance from the station. Combined with directional information from the ground units, the distance information will pinpoint a plane's location.

The distance units on the ground are to be ready for use by the end of June. They will be along air routes. If an automatic unit fails, a spare will automatically take over until the first unit is repaired.

Delivery of the first complete unit of distance measuring equipment for private aviation is scheduled for September. Each unit will retail at about \$1,500 and will weigh about 16 pounds.

Saucer Researcher Says Understanding Needed To Understand Events

A basis of understanding is needed to understand past and recent events relating to beings not of this planet, Daniel W. Fry, West Covina, Calif., missile expert and researcher into the field of flying saucers, told an audience of about 100 persons at Hedrick Junior High school Tuesday night.

"We of earth have been under observation by supreme intelligent beings from another planet for some time," Fry emphasized. "However, people of earth don't like to think of anybody from another planet as superior to them. They have sought means of escaping this reality through ridicule, partial explanation and other devices."

Fry said the Bible mentions 18 instances when material objects or space vehicles of

some sort were sighted in the heavens. Some ancient Arabic texts contain much more detailed explanations, he said. The Bible mentions Elijah ascended to Heaven in a chariot of fire and was seen no more, Fry noted.

Tumor Promoting Substance Found

London - (Science Service) - Compounds known to be capable of promoting the growth of tumors have been isolated from cigarette smoke by two researchers here.

The compounds isolated belong to the phenol family. Their presence in cigarettes was reported in the British journal Nature, March 12, by W. Carruthers and R. A. W. Johnston of the Washington Singer Laboratories, University of Exeter.

The two researchers isolated phenol compounds from British cigarettes. Some of the phenols have recently been identified in Japanese cigarettes while still others have been found in Argentinian cigarettes, they pointed out.

The researchers suggested that a portion of the phenols found in the smoke resulted from the burning of the tobacco.

Modified Truck Tests Rotorcraft

Buffalo, N.Y. - (Science Service) - A special tractor truck for safe "flight" tests of rotorcraft and ducted fan aircraft has been developed for the Army, the Cornell Aeronautical Laboratory here has announced.

The aircraft, sometimes called tomorrow's jeeps, are placed on a tower on the truck. Then the truck is driven along at speeds up to 60 miles per hour.

Instruments measure the effects of the passing air. The laboratory developed the tractor truck because wind tunnels for full scale rotorcraft tests have not been readily available.

Fry also mentioned a "widespread saucer flap" in 1898 and 1902. On one occasion cigar shaped craft hovered over Chicago, were observed by 40,000 people and photographed by a newspaper of that time. During the same period, these craft were seen by large groups of people throughout the country.

A Dr. Warren has translated ancient texts dealing with the wisdom and intelligence

of extra-terrestrial beings, the flying saucer researcher said. The first two chapters were translated 15 years ago and mentioned fusion of hydrogen.

Existence of these supreme beings cannot be explained in earth terms of the five senses, Fry said. People before Columbus and Magellan did not understand the world is round, either, he pointed out.

\$40,000 in Damages Sought in Suit

Luther G. Teague, 124 Tripp st., Medford, is seeking \$40,000 in general damages, and \$2,423.80 in special damages from the Medford hotel, 406 West Main st., as a result of an elevator accident Sept. 10, 1959, according to a complaint filed in the Jackson county circuit court.

Teague alleges in his complaint that, as an employee of Dumas Domestic Laundry and Dry Cleaners company, Medford, he was picking up laundry from the hotel when the accident occurred.

He said the elevator hoist platform had been brought to

the ground floor level for loading, but when he started to back onto it with laundry, the hoist moved from the floor level, causing him to fall into the open well, Teague charged. This resulted in serious injuries, Teague stated. Special damages include loss of earnings totalling \$2,000, medical expenses of \$433.80. He also claims general damages of \$40,000.
