The Building-Up Of Small Breasts

Many women ask me about the operation for building up of small breasts. I know a few surgeons who have spent years studying this problem. What they do usually is to insert a lump of sponge-like plastic back of the breast to push it forward. Naturally, when this work was begun, there were many difficulties, and it took years to develop a type of material which would not quickly contract down into a hard and perhaps lumpy mass. Also, sometimes, pus formed around the inserted material. One of my friends who has been working on the problem for years writes that last year he had no such trouble in a single case.

Marfan's Syndrome

An occasional reader writes to ask what is Marfan's Syndrome. It is a rare disease in which the lenses of the eyes may be dislocated. The head is long from front to back, and the most striking finding may be peculiar spider-like fingers. These people often have diving one of the valves of the heart, and this tends to shorten their life.

I recently read an article by Dr. Dorrance Bowers, of Kelowna, British Columbia, who has observed this disease in 39 members of six generations of one family. And yet, psychiatrists keep telling us, all the time, that there is nothing to heredity in human beings. Actually, we human beings are animals, and hence in our bodies we have to follow the laws of genetics which have been worked out so perfectly for animals.

Driving Record Spoiled by Plane
