The international student delegation is touring southern Oregon under the leadership of Russel Walker, secretary of the student YMCA in Eugene.

They were guests of the Medford Rotary club and gave a program of talks and music. Tuesday afternoon the visiting students attended classes at the Medford High school as guests of the International Relations club.

Meet Families
Later they met host families at the YMCA social hall and Tuesday night attended a potluck dinner at the Y. They were overnight guests in several Medford homes to provide an opportunity to become acquainted with American family life, according to Robert L. Jones, Y general secretary.

Mrs. Scott Wickersham introduced the guests at the dinner. They gave a music and dance program followed by a discussion period. About 125 persons attended.

Their southern Oregon tour includes visits to industries and social institutions in Ashland and Klamath Falls, where they will be guests of the Indians at Klamath agency, and to Crater Lake.

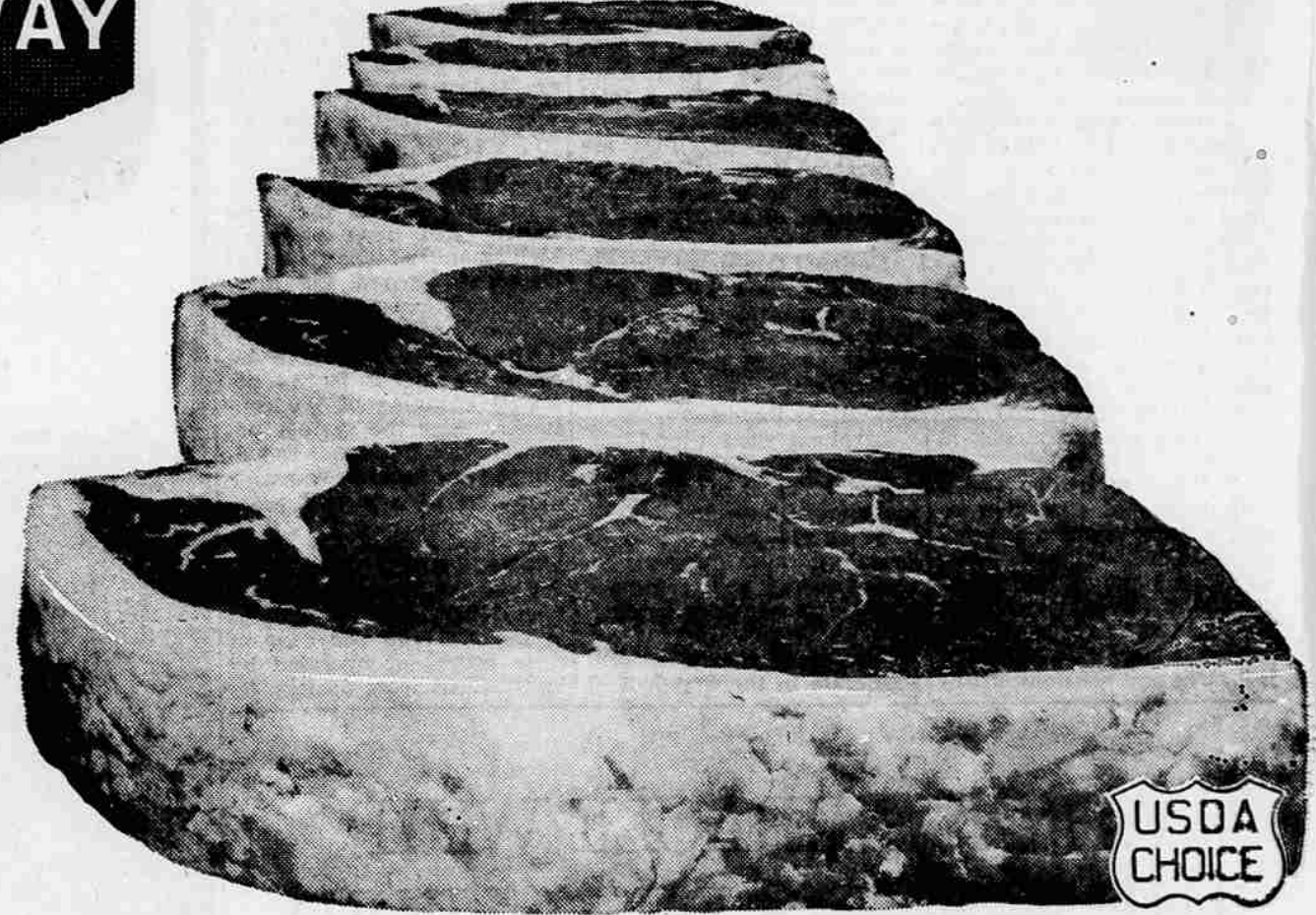
