### Muscle Signals Said of Help To Diagnose Disease

New York (Science Service)- Muscles broadcast not only relatively powerful signals, but also very weak high-frequency electrical signals, two physicians reported here.

The new range of weak signals has been detected with a recently perfected ultra-quiet amplifier. This new technique may eventually explain often questioned natural phenomena such as telepathy and extrasensory perception, and may even add further knowledge to the well-established phenomenon of hypnosis, they stated.

#### Pattern Affected

For now the doctors' findings may aid in diagnosing muscular diseases. The physicians said abnormalities in muscle structure affect the frequency pattern of the voltages generated by the muscle.

The work was reported by Drs. W. K. Volkens of Cohu Electronics and W. Candib of St. Claire Hospital, both of Schenectady, N.Y., to the Institute of Radio Engineers meeting here.

The physicians used a new ultra-low-noise transistor amplifier to pick up muscle signals up to 50,000 cycles per second in frequency. They found such ailments as muscle thickening, retention of water and diminished blood supply each had its own frequency pattern.

#### Signals Commonly Used

More powerful muscle signals of a few hundred cycles per second are already commonly used for diagnosis of the heart (with a cardiograph), brain (with an encephalograph) and muscles (with a myograph).

Because of such marriages of electronics and medicine, Dr. Hans H. Zinsser of the Columbia University College of Physicians and Surgeons here told the convention that a new academic degree must be provided for a new profession: medical engineering.

### More So. Salem Students Suspended

Salem (UPI)-The number of South Salem high school students suspended for "poor conduct" during the state basketball tournament last week in Eugene is up to 15.

They include both girls and boys and the suspensions run from two days to a week, Principal Carl Aschenbrenner said Friday.

The action followed reports of drinking of liquor at the tournament, Aschenbrenner said. Many other students have been placed on probation, he said.

### Former GH Woman Dies in Midwest

Gold Hill - Word was received here last week of the recent death of Mrs. Margaret Galligar in Council Bluffs, Iowa. Burial was in the family plot at Walnut Hills cemetery there.

Mrs. Galligar, a former resident of southern Oregon, taught school in the Gold Hill school about 30 years ago, and was well known as a singer and artist.

She also taught in the Medford school system, and directed a Shakespearean play, "Twelfth Night", which was presented by Medford pupils at the old Page theater.

Mrs. Galligar also lived in the Grants Pass area.
