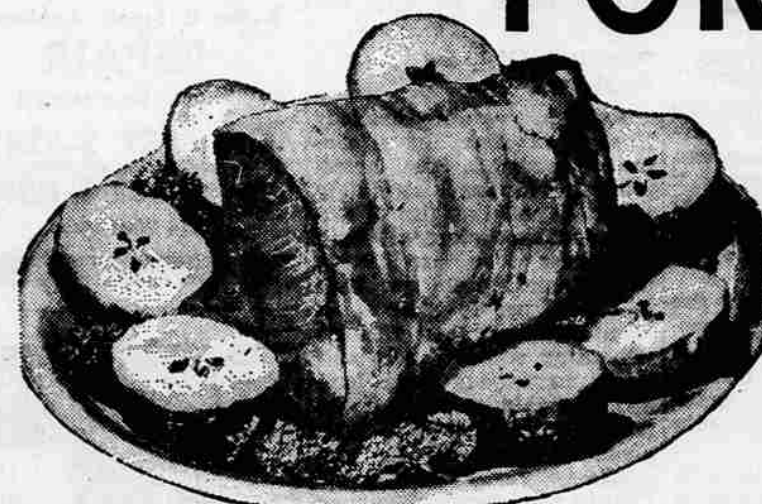

Russia's Flu Vaccine Believed Inferior To U.S.

Chicago - (Science Service) - Russia's live virus influenza vaccine appears to be less effective than America's killed virus vaccine, a Denver researcher said here.

The Russians have concentrated on live influenza vaccines, which are made from live but weakened viruses and administered by nasal inhalation. Vaccines used in this country are made from killed viruses and administered by injection.

Moderately Effective

The live virus vaccine proved to be moderately effective in boosting antibody levels in persons who had no such previous disease-fighters before contact with the vaccine. Persons who had acquired antibodies before inhaling the vaccine, however, showed little booster effect, Dr. Gordon Meikeljohn of the University of Colorado School of Medicine reported in the Journal of the American Medical Association.

Furthermore, the American vaccine, made from killed viruses, proved more effective than the live vaccine in raising antibody levels of persons who had antibodies at the time of the vaccination.

The report was based on observations of the responses of 27 volunteers who received the live vaccine. No illness was observed in these persons.
