

# County-Wide Study of Water Table Is Urged

A county-wide study of the water table and drainage problem was urged Friday by John S. Weisbrod, Medford, former Jackson county planning commission member.

As a first step, Weisbrod recommended hiring "a top level" planning technician to coordinate the work of the county watermaster's department with that of the health

department in making a study of the water table in relation to wells and surface water along with a substrata study.

Such a study would provide a monthly report of water conditions. Both departments need more college-trained personnel, he suggested.

"Substrata data from well-diggers' logs on drilling is available, but has not been

plotted so it could be used for county planning in relation to home construction and creation of subdivisions," Weisbrod pointed out.

## Research on Human Heredity Shows Spotlight

I read recently in Science News Letter that the deans of 84 medical schools agree that in 1959, research on man's heredity stole the spotlight. Some of the workers even got a Nobel Prize. Professor William S. Stone feels, as do many other scientists, that in 1959, the biggest single achievement of medical research was the discovery of many facts about the chemistry of human genetics. Two of the complicated essential chemicals in the nucleus of cells have been synthesized. This was a magnificent achievement.

All of this makes me feel justified and glad because for the past few years I have been prophesying that as soon as medical men develop the courage to break away from the long-existing psychiatric tabu against any study or even mention of human heredity, medical research will jump ahead into a wonderful new field. Then, many men will throw great new light on the nature of a number of now puzzling diseases. In that day, men may even have the courage to read the big book on human heredity which I pub-
