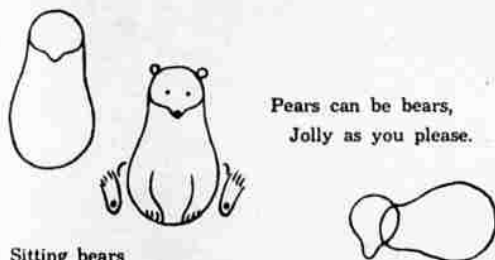
Indoor Fishing Game

Here's a game called "Indoor Fishing." Cut a couple of dozen fish shapes from heavy paper or cardboard. Number them. Attach a piece of string about three feet long to the head of each fish with a strip of cellophane tape. Put all the fish, numbered side down, in a clothes basket or big box with the strings hanging over the side. Put in a few extra strings with no fish on them so some players will pull up an empty hook. Then take turns pulling a string from the basket. Players count the numbers on their fish, and the one with the highest score wins.

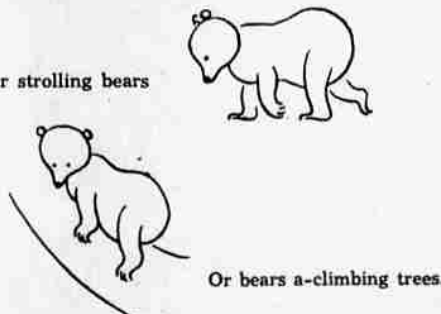

Or strolling bears

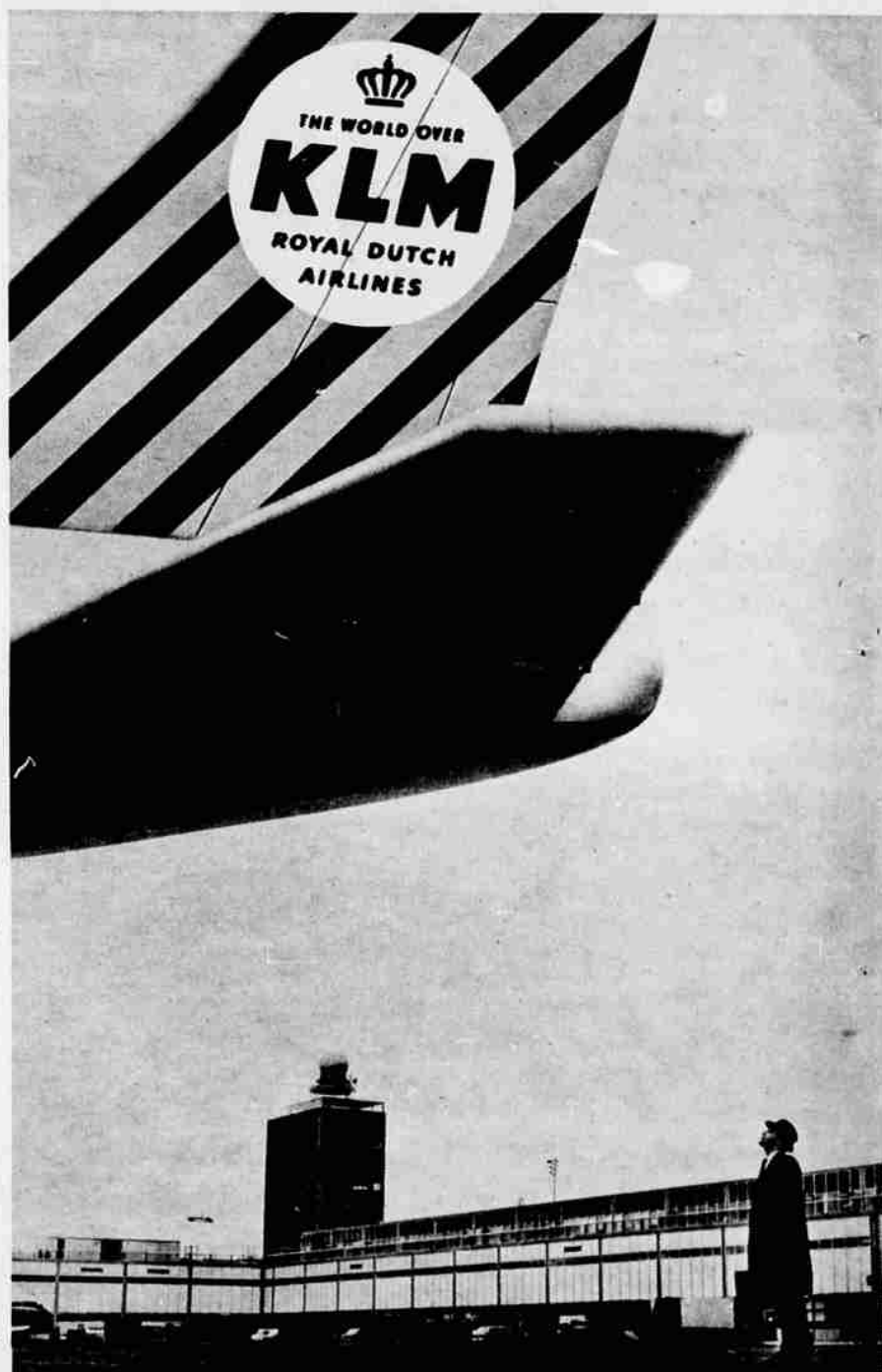


Or bears a-climbing trees.
