

Elements Opposing Fidel Castro's Regime Said Organizing in Florida

Louis Armstrong To Play at State Fair
Salem — (UPI) — Louis Armstrong and his band have been signed for the 1960 Oregon State Fair, Manager Howard Maple said today.
The famed jazz trumpeter will head the fair revue and Maple said that to accommodate the big crowds expected, there will be two shows nightly.
The State Fair begins Sept. 2 and runs through the 10th.

Editor's note: This is the first of three dispatches on Cuban intrigue on the U.S. mainland. It deals with activities of a new group opposed to the government of Premier Fidel Castro.

Miami — (UPI) — Revolution has the smell of a Havana cigar.

One step off Miami's tourist-jammed Brickell ave. brings you to the ordinary lobby of an ordinary hotel. Waiting in the lobby are men whose heavy, dark sun glasses have replaced the trench coat as the badge of the revolutionary.

The men await the pleasure of "El Presidente."

He is seven floors up, in a suite of rooms overlooking Biscayne Bay and the buildings of downtown Miami. There the neatly-suited men behind the dark eyeglasses are trying to pull together the elements that oppose Cuban Premier Fidel Castro.

Guns and bullets are not in

the picture yet. So far it is a propaganda cold war, one of organization. The little group has no name, but it has a leader.

Well-Heeled Boss
He is Francisco J. Cajigas, a slow-speaking custom-tailored millionaire who fancies \$100 western style hats.

Before Castro, Cajigas had extensive business interests in Cuba and the Isle of Pines, mostly in cattle.

Almost shy—his left arm is paralyzed and he has two fingers missing from the hand he keeps in his coat pocket—Cajigas never has held political office. He maintains a residence at Mount Dora, a sleepy lakeside town in north central Florida.

A reporter cannot approach the tall, muscular man with the thatch of thick but receding brown hair, graying at the temples. He sent word, "It is too soon."

An announcement that Cajigas has been chosen "president" of a Cuban government in exile leaked out before he and his associates were ready.

Barring the way is rangy Hector de Lara who attended P.S. 10 in New York and emerged with slightly accented English.

"You understand, I am sure," said de Lara, politely. "We cannot say anything now."

"After all, Senor Cajigas feels he is a guest in your country and he does not want to abuse your hospitality."

Don't Get Caught

The game is not to get caught violating the U.S. Neutrality Act, a law that prohibits any activity within U.S. borders that would be harmful to a friendly country.

If shooting starts, a key figure in the anti-Castro movement would be Jose Pedraza,

a former army general who fled Cuba with dictator Fulgencio Batista to the Dominican Republic. Castro has accused Pedraza, now named military leader of Cajigas' unit group, of secretly training a Cuban invasion force in the Dominican Republic under the approving eye of Domini-

can dictator Rafael Trujillo. Watchful U.S. officials in Miami said there is little doubt that an anti-Castro drive is gaining momentum outside Cuba.

Joseph Fortier, supervising customs here, said Miami is a starting point in a Caribbean ring drawn around the beard-

ed leader's island. "He's practically surrounded," Fortier said. "There are anti-Castro people in the Dominican Republic, Miami, Central America, Venezuela and other Latin American countries. And they are developing muscle."

To Keep Watch
The U. S. government is putting unlisted forces of men, material and money into the south Florida area to keep tabs on the Latin intrigue and head off embarrassing incidents.

Watching 200 airfields, a dozen ports and 50,000 Cubans is a big job.

"There are any number of little groups but they appear to be leaderless," Fortier said. "This Cajigas may be what they've been looking for."

The anti-Castro cells carry such names as the White Rose, The Tigers, The Hawks. But Cajigas' aides said they are avoiding linkage with them

and such figures as Maj. Pedro Diaz Lanz, Castro's former air force chief, and Rolando Masferrer, the dated right-hand man of Batista.

Right now it appears that anti-Castro groups are trying only to undermine the premier's policies within Cuba, Fortier said.
