**Guilty Plea Made  
In Truck Bombing**

Portland - (UPI) - Gerald A. Couzens, 20, pleaded guilty to a charge of taking part in the Jan. 31 dynamiting of newspaper trucks here. Circuit Judge Herbert A. Schwab ordered a presentence investigation. Couzens earlier had entered an innocent plea although he confessed taking part in the dynamiting. Judge Schwab asked Couzens if he understood the meaning of a guilty plea. Couzens replied "It means I took part in this crime." Couzens' confession implicated Levi McDonald, 51, striking stereotyper, who has maintained his innocence and is scheduled to go on trial later this month.

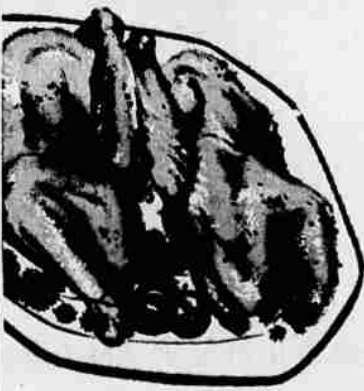

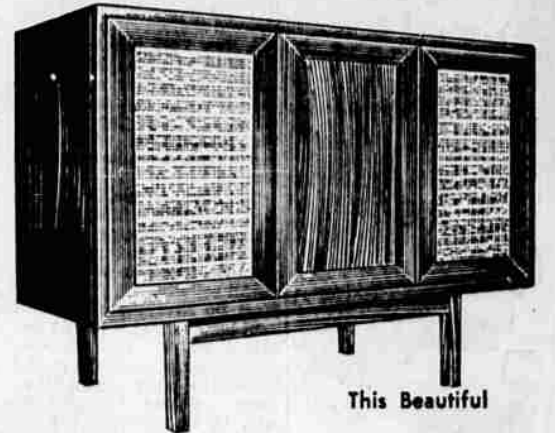
