

Palm Benediction Scheduled Sunday

In accordance with ancient tradition of the church, the benediction of the Palms will take place at the 8 a.m. Holy Eucharist at St. Mark's Episcopal church Sunday.

The Palms, especially imported from the Holy Land for the purpose, will adorn the altar, be carried by the choir in procession, and the remainder will be fashioned into small crosses by members of the Altar guild and be distributed to worshippers on Palm Sunday, the first day of Holy Week.

According to traditional practice these crosses are retained until Ash Wednesday of the following year when they are burned at the start of another Lenten season. The Rev. George R. V. Bolster will preach at both 9:30 and 11 a.m. services, with musical selections by the choir under the direction of John E. Drysdale.

During Holy Week the Eucharist will be celebrated each day, Monday through Thursday, at 11 and 7 a.m. alternately.

Good Friday, April 15, the Three Hour Vigil at the Cross will be observed from 12 noon to 3 p.m. with the clergy leading meditations on the Seven Last Words. This service will be so arranged that worshippers may come and go at indicated intervals during the afternoon.
