Memphis, Tenn. (UPI)—Vernon Presley, 44-year-old widower father of singer Elvis Presley, announced Thursday he will marry Mrs. Davada Elliott, pretty blonde divorcee and mother of three.

Presley said Elvis will be the man at the wedding, which will be "in the very near future."

The 31-year-old Mrs. Elliott, nicknamed "Dee," met Presley in Germany in 1958. Mrs. Elliott was there with her ex-husband, an Army sergeant, and Presley moved to Germany when Elvis was stationed there by the Army.

Mrs. Elliott said her sons, Billy, 7, Richard, 6, and David, 4 — "are very happy having Elvis as a brother."

"They think he's wonderful," she said.
