Conflict of Interest Cases Being Studied

Washington—Rep. Alfred E. Santangelo (D-N.Y.) says that "12 new cases of conflict of interest" involving high Agriculture Department officials are under investigation.

Santangelo, a member of the House Agricultural Appropriations subcommittee, said the cases involving officials who are concerned with the government's grain storage program.

In all, Santangelo said, "12 cases of conflict of interest are now under study." Questionnaires sent to an Agriculture Department spokesman said the department sent a questionnaire in December to several thousand employees telling them to list their outside interests.

As a result of this questionnaire, he said, there are 12 cases in which the department is making further inquiries. He said these were not necessarily conflict of interest cases, nor were all 12 persons assigned to grain storage work.

Santangelo brought up the matter in an interview by chairman Emanuel Celler (D-N.Y.) of the House Judiciary Committee.

Why Does Diabetes Appear Late in Life? Dozens of older persons ask why, if diabetes is an inheritable disease, did they have to wait until their later years to get it?

Occasionally I see a man of 60 who feels very old and tired, as if he were petering out, and then perhaps a most careful examination will show nothing definitely wrong with any part of his body.

Often, a doctor suspects that a person with a slight inborn tendency to diabetes developed it because he ate so much starch and sugar that he put much strain on his (born weak) pancreatic cells.

Oftentimes, when I see an old person with degenerating arteries who is developing diabetes, I suspect that tiny arteries in his pancreas have been plugging-up and leaving the insulin-forming cells with so little blood that they are unable to work well.

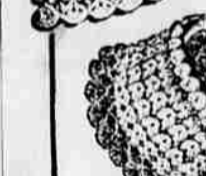
