Beverly Adland's Alleged Boy Friend Killed by Gunshot

Hollywood—UPI—The handsome young actor who allegedly tried to replace the late Errol Flynn in Beverly Adland's affections has followed his predecessor in death.

William Stanciu, who played bit parts in pictures, died Sunday at General Hospital on his 21st birthday. Seventeen-year-old Beverly said Stanciu shot himself in the head playing Russian roulette after forcing his way into her apartment Saturday and raping her.

Stanciu's brother, another bit actor who goes by the name Shawn Tanner, 22, took exception to Miss Adland's version of the shooting.

Just about everything she said is wrong," he said. "It just doesn't add up. There's something very fishy about her story."

Tanner scoffed at Beverly's tale that Stanciu's violent actions apparently were caused by her spurning of his declared love for her.

"That's a pack of lies," said Tanner. "Beverly asked Billy to marry her a few weeks ago."

Stanciu's mother, Mrs. Florence Adland, backed up her son's assertion.

"Beverly loved and adored Billy," said Mrs. Stanciu. "He was a real gentleman. Errol Flynn and my son were the only people that ever treated her like anything but a tramp."

Tanner said, "My brother didn't run after Beverly... he was a body-builder, a good-looking guy who had all the girls he wanted."

"He had everything to live for. I don't believe he killed himself. He loved life too much."

Beverly, who last month made her debut as a nightclub singer, was placed in juvenile hall Saturday after she called police to her apartment.

There they found Stanciu near-nude and wounded in the head. Police booked him on an assault charge and later listed his death as apparent suicide.
