### A Child With a Large Head

Some very unhappy mothers write to ask if anything more can be done for a child with hydrocephalus (a big head due to "water on the brain"). If the child has been seen by a good brain surgeon, who doubts the wisdom of a t e m p t i n g any operation, I think the parents had better give up. I would not advise them to travel about, especially if already the child is mentally retarded, and too weak to sit up. It is sad, but we have no medicine to cure this condition. Fluid that is being formed in the inside of the brain cannot get out where it can be absorbed, as it does in a normal child. There is something in the way.

### Why Constant Belching?

Some people who admit that they are "a terrible bunch of nerves, and afraid of everything" want to know why they are belching by the hour. No amount of dieting and taking of drugs has helped them. What is wrong? All that is wrong is that the person has learned the trick of gulping down air and then belching it out again. It is an accomplishment of no value socially. It is like biting one's nails or cracking one's knuckles. There is only one way to cure the disgusting habit, and that is to stop it by will power. In many cases the belching is a sign of fear or great worry over something. Hence the treatment is not a diet and not a medicine. I remember a business man who said he had taken to belching loudly and constantly from 10 p.m. to 2 a.m. when he fell asleep because of sheer exhaustion. I found his fear was that his company was going to fail. He was angry with me when I showed him that he was swallowing big gulps of air that went down as far as his midriff and then were belched out again. But, with the help of a sedative, he was able to quit the habit that very night, and that was the end of it.

### Woman, 57, Still Fears She May Bear Child

Every month I get letters from women who want to know when, after the age of 45 or so, they can stop worrying about getting pregnant. Many remain anxious long after they have stopped menstruating. The champion of all worriers is a woman who, at 57, is still arguing with her husband and telling him that she might still get pregnant. He husband thinks that she should have quit worrying 10 years ago, and I agree with him.

### As I have said several times in this column, big obstetric clinics report that they have very rarely seen a woman bear a child after the age of 47. If a woman should conceive around this time of life, she would be likely to abort. If she stops menstruating, and goes into the menopause, she has almost no chance of bearing a child. The only trouble for a very worrisome woman will be the statement of some old obstetrician that, once or twice in his life, he confined a woman who was 50 or even 52.

Actually, I should think that a woman over 47 who hasn't menstruated for six months, and perhaps is having bad flashes, should stop worrying.

## Report Made on Anti-Germ Agents

Cleveland—(Science Service)—A one-step chemical synthesis of powerful germ-fighting agents was reported to the American Chemical Society meeting here by Dr. Edward J. Modest, head of the laboratories for organic chemistry at the Children's Cancer Research Foundation, Inc., Boston.

He said a wide variety of 2,4-diaminopyrimidine compounds have been synthesized in a one-step chemical process. The substances actively inhibit folic acid metabolism in some biological systems, especially in the streptococcus faecalis, the germ that often causes human urinary infections.

The meeting also heard Dr. M. Gershenzon of Bell Telephone Laboratories, Murray Hill, N. J., report that a rare, transparent gallium phosphide was achieved in experiments aimed at growing extremely pure crystals of this material. The crystals were "rather small" and strain-free, but they transmit light of wavelengths longer than green (toward the red end of the spectrum).
