**New Delhi Needs Expert Dog Shooters**

New Delhi—Wanted—A dog shooter. Salary 35 rupees (\$6.50) per month. New Delhi Corporation has invited applications from persons expert in doing in stray dogs.

The post, advertised in all the local English and native dailies, offers the selected candidate an increment of 21 cents per year.

The salary will go up to \$9.50 a month at the end of 15 years meritorious service. "Untouchables" will be given preference for the job.

The notice does not list the duties of the dog shooter. But corporation authorities said they expect him to be on the look out for all stray dogs in the capital and to shoot them on sight.

They said stray dogs have become a nuisance to the people of Delhi, causing several rabies cases each year.

They estimated there are 13,000 stray dogs in Delhi's streets. Most of them inhabit slum areas.

A corporation authority explained that dog killing is an art. It takes 10 to 12 men to chase a stray dog before he is caught.

He said a stray dog has an amazing "horse sense" to smell his "enemy" and the catcher has to use his best talents.
