

## Ike Prepares for De Gaulle Talks

Augusta, Ga. — (UPI) — President Eisenhower spent two hours Saturday in intensive preparation for his forthcoming Washington talks with French President Charles de Gaulle and the May 16 summit meeting in Paris.

The President's son, Maj. John S. Eisenhower, in his role as assistant White House staff secretary, brought with him from Washington Friday a number of secret documents relating to the de Gaulle visit, the summit and the chief executive's June trip to Russia and the Far East.

Wayne Hawks, acting White House press secretary, called the conference this morning "quite an extensive session in preparation for the summit."

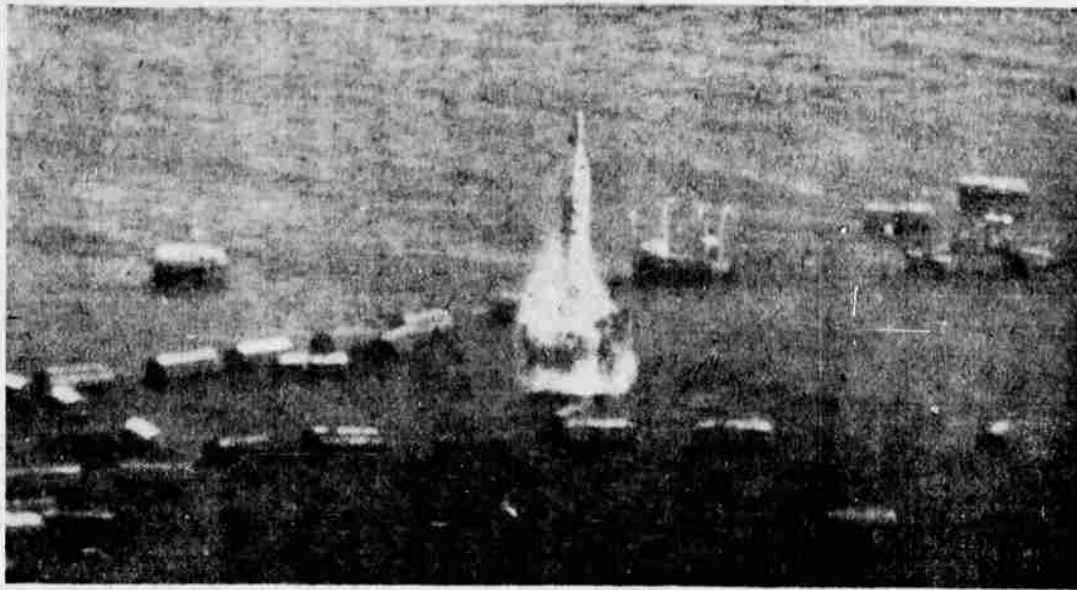
## Hoffa Attempts to Block Federal Trial

Washington — (UPI) — Teamsters' President James R. Hoffa, anxious to block his trial before Federal Judge F. Dickinson Letts on charges of misusing union funds, demanded Saturday that the 84-year-old jurist disqualify himself in the case.

Hoffa filed papers in district court accusing Letts of harboring a "personal bias and prejudice" against him in overseeing a clean-up of the Teamsters by court-named monitors.

Hoffa contended in his affidavit that Letts already has decided to oust him from the \$50,000-a-year presidency of the union before the trial has started.

## Navy Ships May Get Orb Signal

Washington — (UPI) — America's new transit navigational satellite is circling the earth, the first in a series of guideposts in the sky to direct missile-firing ships and help prevent ocean liner and airplane collisions.

The Navy, jubilant over the successful launching, said all its ships would be equipped to receive signals from the satellite if the system lived up to expectations. The signals would enable skippers to plot their position within one-

quarter of a mile in any kind of weather.

When missile-launching ships and submarines go into full operation in 1962, they

could use the satellite to determine their exact position at sea. This pin-point location is impossible now but is needed to zero in on a target.
