What Is The Law?

Insurance Can Be Paid To Beneficiary In Many Ways

When Ivan decided to take out a life insurance policy on his life in order to protect his wife, Tina, he found there were a variety of arrangements that could be made relative to payment of the proceeds of the insurance. Tina could be named beneficiary and, upon Ivan's death, the policy would provide that Tina could get the proceeds in a lump sum or have it paid to her over a period of years by the insurance company. If Tina elected to have the company keep the money for her, there were several alternative methods of payment that she could choose.

Ivan also found out that he could name a trust company as beneficiary of the policy. He would enter into an agreement with the trust company to use the proceeds of the policy for the benefit of Tina and any children that Ivan and Tina might have. The trust company would be instructed to pay the money to Tina periodically during her lifetime.

Must Consider Factors

In deciding whether to name Tina or a trust company as beneficiary Ivan should consider the following factors. Most courts have held that an insurance company holding the proceeds of a policy for a beneficiary is not a trustee. The company is a debtor of the beneficiary. Therefore, the money really belongs to the insurance company and the company has the duty to pay the beneficiary in accordance with the terms of the option selected by the beneficiary. The amount that the beneficiary will receive each year is normally a fixed amount that will not be changed by economic forces. If a trust company receives the proceeds a trust is created and the company must exercise reasonable care and skill

Pilots Association Checking Electras

Washington—(UPI)—The president of the Airline Pilots association said Saturday the ALPA is conducting its own investigation of Electra airliners and will refuse to fly them if it decides they should be grounded.

Clarence Sayen, head of the ALPA with headquarters in Chicago, told United Press International the pilots' group has been "watching the whole thing closely" since two of the prop-jet Electras were involved in recent mysterious crashes.

"We have engineers at Lockheed plants and inspectors in all regions of the country," Sayen said. "If we decide the plane should be banned, we'll do it ourselves by just refusing to fly them."

Gamble and Hubby Arrive in Texas

San Antonio, Tex. — (UPI)—Honeymooning heiress Gamble Benedict and Andre Porumbanu arrived in San Antonio from New Orleans Saturday in a rented car and checked into a downtown hotel.
