

Variety of Shoes for Spring Give Modern Spectator Look

It's a spectator spring in women's shoes, but with an exciting new difference—says the Shoe Fashion service of Leather Industries of America.

Instead of few classic brown or navy and white styles—the 1960 spectator gives inspiration to dozens and dozens of new shoes for every occasion. Exquisite leathers—smooth and grained kid, brushed leather, as soft as swan's down, gleaming patent leathers—are imaginatively combined and stamped with the modern spectator look.

Low-Priced
Ninety-five per cent of the new leather spectators are in the low-to-moderate price category, scaled to the average budget.

In daytime shoes, wide perforations vie with tiny ones in smooth calf, in wing-tip patterns and bands of neat stitching along the top of the shoe! Set on a low or mid heel, in self or stacked leather, it's a versatile all-occasion shoe for

the urbanite or suburbanite. In other styles, smooth or grained leather toes with fleur-de-lis designs contrast with brushed or suede leather bodies, in lighter shades of brown, blue, purple or gray.

The boot look adds still more excitement to the spring scene! Instead of coming up above the ankles, the spring boot-pump and walking oxford with its high-rising vamp merely "suggests" a boot.

To keep these high-risers light enough for spring comfort, the lightweight leather uppers have large perforations or slits, vamp or instep cut-out, or open-collar effects at the top of the vamp.

Spectators Popular
Contrasting leather textures are tops more now, since the spectator style especially lends itself so well to combinations.

Washable white leathers, with strongly defined grains,

will be extremely popular! Besides obviously easy-care advantage, washable white is as porous as other leathers keeping feet cool and comfortable!

In after-dark shoes, the spectator look is also used to fascinating advantage! Designers dot the leather with tiny nailheads, rhinestones or marcasites in spectator patterns.

Textures Used
Leather textures are contrasted, as in black suede with a black patent . . . or as in royal purple suede with a scalloped edge trimmed in gold calf, or the style in which strips of glistening gold and silver kid are interwoven.

Trim leather soles, with unique shape-holding qualities, help underline the neat line of the spectator look.

Extended soles are often outlined in black to focus attention on the tapered, pointed, oval or squared-off silhouette of the shoe.
