Britain Develops Missile Detector

London - UPI - The London Evening Standard said Wednesday Britain is developing a "radar device" to blow up missiles over the country that fires them.

The radar device was described as being able "to detect a rocket missile over the horizon and explode its H-bomb warhead over the country which fired it."

The Evening Standard said the new device will have "a profound effect on the whole balance of power between East and West and on the disarmament negotiations."

The newspaper said the Ministry of Defense has ordered a vast research program to perfect the instrument but that details of it were "top secret."

"It is understood that a team of American experts is already in this country evaluating the progress," said the Standard.

Jet Planes Appear As Objects on Sun

London - (Science Service) - Jet planes flying some six miles high in the earth's atmosphere can appear as bright surges on the sun, a Swedish astronomer has discovered.

Dr. Yngve Ohman of Stockholm observatory saw a dark surge-like object for about two seconds, but could find no other observations of a similar kind for the same time. Through cooperation of the Swedish Air Force, jet planes were flown so as to appear to cross the sun's visible surface when the sun was low on the horizon.

Although "very surprising," the bright solar surges then seen were found to be due to the jet planes. Dr. Ohman has communicated his findings to The Observatory, scientific journal published at the Royal Greenwich observatory, Herstmonceux Castle, Hailsham, in Sussex.
