

Motorists Warned About Youngsters

Backed by statistics showing an average of two children injured every day in Oregon traffic, Medford's Chief of Police Charles P. Champlin cautioned motorists to watch out for children who are not watching out for themselves.

Motorists should watch for such things as children playing near the roadway, jaywalking, running from behind parked cars, crossing against traffic signals or using poor bicycling techniques, he said.

Champlin pointed out that 775 children were injured and 28 killed in car-pedestrian and car-bicyclist accidents in Oregon last year. Another 23 youngsters were killed and 1,853 injured who were passengers in cars involved in accidents.

He said "there has been a gratifying reduction in traffic

mishaps around schools because of school patrols, traffic officers, signals and other devices, but parents now need to caution their children on traffic self-discipline when they are away from school areas."

Good home and school safety programs plus alert motorists, all contribute to a formula for child traffic safety, he said.

AN ORDINANCE providing for the construction of a sanitary sewer in Niantic Street to serve the property on the West side of Niantic Street, between Maple Street and Putnam Street in the City of Medford, Oregon, identified as follows:

Section 1. That it is the intention of the Council to cause the construction of a sanitary sewer in Niantic Street to serve the property on the West side of Niantic Street, between Maple Street and Putnam Street in the City of Medford, in accordance with the hereby adopted and identified plan and specifications on file in the office of the City Manager, at which plans and specifications reference is hereby made for details and estimated cost of said sewer and to assess upon each lot, or part thereof, adjacent to and benefited by such improvement its proportionate share of the cost of said improvement as provided by the Charter of the City of Medford.

Section 2. The Council will meet in the Council Chambers at the City Hall on the 30th day of May, 1960, at 7:30 P.M. at which time and place the owners of said adjacent property are hereby called upon to appear before said Council and show cause, if any, why said improvement should not be constructed, and why said property should not be assessed for the construction of said sewer.

Section 3. That warrants for the costs of the aforementioned improvement shall bear interest at four per cent (4%) per annum and shall constitute general obligations of the City of Medford, and said warrants shall be issued pursuant to, and on the terms and conditions set forth in, Oregon Revised Statutes 287.502 to 287.510, inclusive.

Section 4. The City Recorder is hereby directed to serve notice hereof upon the property owners of said property by publishing this Ordinance once in a daily newspaper, printed and published and of general circulation in said City at least ten (10) days before the date of said meeting, and by posting five copies of this Ordinance in five public and conspicuous places in said City for a period of ten (10) days prior to said meeting.
