**Inheritance of Prematurely Gray Hair**

A woman writes me that her daughter began to get gray when she was 12. This is a distressing problem for the girl and her mother. I imagine it would be best for the mother to have the hair dyed.

In the next 50 years this idea of carriers must become one of the most important in medicine. In thousands of cases it explains why a person with epilepsy will say, "But it cannot be hereditary because neither my parents nor my grandparents had the disease." Then, I have electroencephalograms made, and perhaps I find that the mother and the mother's father have typically epileptic records. They are carriers of disease. Usually, they have some nervous symptoms that I can recognize as epileptic in origin.
