For years, thoughtful persons have worried because it looked as if the children of the future were likely to be born mainly to the more ignorant half of the population. People in the slums, who have little concern as to whether their children will get an education, often have a child a year, while people with more training who want children to be well-educated, if they have a small income, do not have more than a child or two. Now, in a study of the fertility of college graduates, made by the Population Reference Bureau of Washington, D.C., we see that in 1957 there has been a tendency for college graduates to have more children than younger age, and to have, on an average, two children per mother. The figures for 1949 show families averaging twice the size of those for graduates in 1957. It is true that occasionally a remarkable scientist is born to uneducated people in very humble circumstances, but if one will study hundreds of the brief biographies in "Who's Who in America," one will find that a high percentage of our most able and distinguished citizens had well-educated parents.
