### Fine Arts Program Given For Travel Study Club

Mrs. Walter Brown, Klamath Falls, president of Oregon Federation of Women's clubs, was guest speaker for a meeting of Travel Study club held Tuesday in the fireplace room at the Girls Community club. Mrs. Brown spoke on the fine arts program of the General Federation of Women's clubs and also of the Oregon Federation.

The penny art fund, now known as silver art fund, was initiated in 1930, and members of the General Federation have contributed \$100,000 to further art appreciation, encourage American artists, and support art scholarships, she said. The plan is national in scope but local in interests and benefits, the funds being spent within the state where they are collected, Mrs. Brown stated.

Another art project of the General Federation of Women's Clubs begun in 1953, is the art talent contest for senior high school students. In cooperation with the Hallmark Greeting Card company the federation awards each year scholarships in art training to three students selected from several hundred contestants, she said.

Mrs. Brown commended and thanked Travel Study club for all the "outstanding accomplishments" during the year.

Warren Wolf, art instructor of Medford High school, also spoke on fine arts. Mr. Wolf introduced Dick Day, who won the Hallmark contest in Oregon and will compete in the national, and Terry Ryan, who entered the contest. Mr. Wolf showed and explained different media of paintings in which both students have worked. He stated that throughout history, when a community felt deeply about certain patriotic or religious subjects, some artist was able to express the spirit and enthusiasm of what was called "the voice of the people," though his own identity was lost. "The craftsman with willing hands and an overpowering desire to create something beautiful brings forth his inspiration with pride and satisfaction," the instructor said. "If our eyes are attuned to the vision a painter has seen, we too, find pleasure and happiness," he added.

Miss Mary Savage, of Crater High school, and sponsored by Medford Junior Women's club in the Hallmark contest, spoke to the group and explained paintings she exhibited.

Paintings by Mrs. Thomas Reid, Mrs. Willis T. Fasel and Mrs. Beryl Lyon, members of Travel Study club, were also exhibited. Mrs. Clay M. Lee, president, presided during the business session.

Election of officers for the ensuing year was held with Mrs. Jack D. Brummond, named president; Mrs. Frank L. Stratton, first vice-president; Mrs. Fred Gross, recording secretary; Mrs. Beryl Lyon, treasurer; and Mrs. Carrie Walker, corresponding secretary.

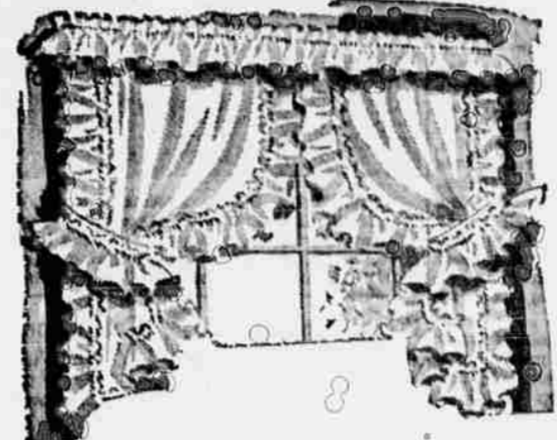

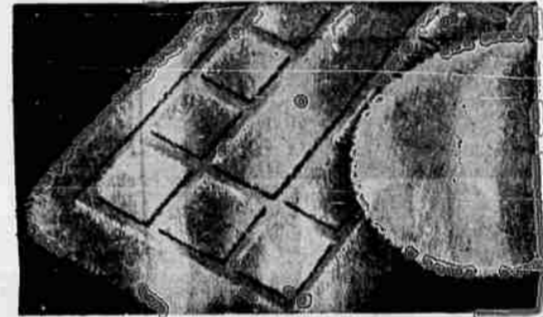
