**Resurrection Fern Stays Alive Under Adverse Conditions**  
If you have never seen the resurrection fern, you have been walking around with your eyes shut; and if you don't recognize it when you are looking right at it, this should acquaint you with one of the most interesting members of the large family of flowerless plants.

Although one of the smallest ferns, it grows in such large colonies that it becomes a conspicuous adornment on most of the forest trees.

They are small, coarse-textured little ferns, the largest single plant seldom being over five inches in height. They are native to the South and readily grow and thrive on rocks, mossy banks near woodland creeks, or on the horizontal branches of trees, being particularly abundant on live oak trees. Once established on a tree limb they eventually will cover the entire branch and extend their range until every inch of the tree is completely covered, except the very underside of the branch. With such a growth the combined numbers of the little ferns look more like moss than what they really are.

**Live Without Water**  
The name resurrection as applied to these plants is well taken, for they have solved the problem of living for long periods without water by assuming a state nearly approaching complete death, and remaining in a state of suspended animation for as long as moisture is not available. During a dry period the colonies of resurrection ferns on the limb of a live oak will look dry, brown and lifeless.

In fact the dryness is so complete that you can remove a handful of the plants, rub them between the palms of your hands and they will powder into a fine rust-colored dust.

On the tree limb they resemble dead forest leaves, and you might wonder why the first wind did not blow them all away. But let a rain come, or even a heavy dew, and a wonderful transformation takes place. As the water runs down into and around the tiny roots, and soaks the bark of the live oak tree, each little fern feels the stimulant and proudly lifts its head.

**New Life**  
The brown color that made the plant look so dead washes away as if it had been only a feeble dye, and in its place the fresh green crispness of new life sweeps through it. Once more it resembles a fresh, living fern.

This peculiar power of revival seems never to leave the little plant, and regardless of how many times it is alternately dried out and revived by moisture, it will continue to respond. Once, just for my own satisfaction, I tried soaking and then drying out a small clump of these little ferns. After 80 applications

of the ferns were responding as readily as ever, I became exhausted but the little fellows seemed as peppy as when wetted the first time.

Here is endurance, tolerance and fortitude embodied in a simple little, flowerless plant which has solved the problem of staying alive, even under the most adverse of conditions by adjusting itself to extremes.
