Washington — UPI — Back stairs at the White House:

There has been some interesting research recently on the recreational habits of the men most likely to be president. Particular attention has been paid to their taste in vacations.

This can be frightfully important to the more or less permanent residents of 1600 Pennsylvania Avenue, such as the Secret Service agents, the Signal Corps detail, and the basic House and office staffs.

Sen. John Kennedy of Massachusetts, the Democratic front runner, likes sailing vacations at Hyannisport, Mass., on the exclusive edge of Cape Cod, and sunny winter holidays in the sands of Palm Beach, Fla. This conceivably could bring back the White House yacht, a prerequisite of the presidency until Eisenhower came along and abolished the good ship Williamsburg as a shuddering symbol of luxury.

Right for Nixon

The White House would be just jim-dandy as it stands for Vice President Richard M. Nixon and his family. Nixon and his two girls love swimming. The White House pool is ready and waiting and the girls could have some wonderful splash parties for their school friends. The vice president also likes golf, so the green on the south lawn probably would go undisturbed.

Although the Nixons hail from California, they like winter vacations in Florida, particularly at Key Biscayne near Miami, and at West Palm Beach. Perhaps he might revive Key West as a presidential resort — if the memories of a Democratic president are not too over powering. Eisenhower tried Key West once, but didn't like the golf course. It has been improved since.

Another prominent Democrat, Adlai E. Stevenson, probably would keep the tennis court if he were elected president. Stevenson once was a golfer, but gave it up in favor of tennis. He's the quiet type on vacations and prefers places like Pinehurst, N.C., or Aiken, S.C.

Sen. Stuart Symington of Missouri likes golf, hunting and deep sea fishing. The hunting is excellent in the Maryland mountains near Camp David. The Symingtons take their holidays in South Florida and on an old estate of Mrs. Symington's family near Geneseo, N.Y.

Sen. Lyndon B. Johnson of Texas, another Democratic prospect, he is so incurably Texan that much of any holiday time is spent at home. Home is a vast ranch 80 miles outside Austin, where the Senate Democratic leader likes to lounge beside his kidney-shaped swimming pool and telephone back to Washington.

Housing for a White House travel party on or near the Johnson ranch might present some problems. It might be interesting at that.

Secret Service men in chaps and ten gallon hats, for example, packing their guns in low-slung hip holsters. And the squawk of walkie talkie radios around the ranch campfires at night, plus a melancholy guitar telling sad stories of days gone by, of days in air conditioned hotels with room service and television in every room.

Direct Dialing Due at Portland

Portland — UPI — Direct distance dialing from some 160,000 Portland telephones with Atlantic, Belmont and Capital prefixes will go into effect about one year from now, A. V. Smith, Portland division manager for Pacific Telephone-Northwest, said Thursday.

Direct dialing of long distance calls will follow about one year later from other Portland telephones as well as from nearby communities served by Pacific Telephone-Northwest. Nearby communities slated to have direct distance dialing in 1962 include Oswego, Milwaukie - Oak Grove, Oregon City, Burlington and North Plains.

LIFT EMERGENCY RULES

Cape Town, South Africa — UPI — The South African government has lifted emergency regulations in 20 rural districts for the first time since they were imposed in the midst of March racial violence. The announcement was believed to be the first in a series which would end the state of emergency throughout the country, except in areas where 1,800 persons are being held in jail.
