Medford police received reports of seven traffic accidents Thursday, but only one of them resulted in any injuries.

Sylvia Edith Logan, 69, Talent was taken to Sacred Heart hospital with abrasions of the right elbow and knee following a two-car traffic accident at the intersection of Hamilton and 10th sts., at 5 p.m., police said.

She was a passenger in a car operated by Robert Clyde Logan, 71, also of Talent, which collided with a car operated by Dennis Fay Misk, 45, of 1309 Mt. Pitt ave. Police cited Logan for failure to yield the right of way to a vehicle on the right.

89 Measles Cases Reported in County

Eighty-nine cases of measles were reported to the Jackson county health department last week, according to Dr. C. I. Drummond, public health physician.

Of the total, 24 cases were reported in Medford, 20 in Ruch, 22 in Ashland, 14 in Evans Valley, 5 in Applegate, 2 in Central Point, and 1 each in Eagle Point and Jacksonville.

Other cases of communicable diseases reported last week include pneumonia, Ruch 1; chicken pox, Medford 4, Rogue River 5; influenza, Central Point 4, Medford 9, Ashland 3; and German measles, Medford 9, Phoenix 1.

Youth Corps Proposal Sent to Eisenhower

Washington—(UPI)—A proposal by the late Sen. Richard L. Neuberger (D-Ore.) calling for a study of the advisability of a point four youth corps has been passed by the House and Senate and sent to the President. Sen. Hall S. Lusk (D-Ore.) said Friday.

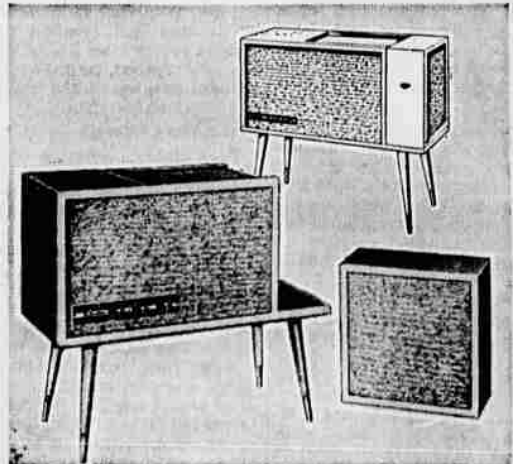

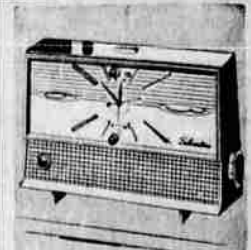
