Prospect Man Gets Timber Contract

Louis Biden of Prospect, with a total bid of \$251,153.50, was awarded the Prospect Flat Select 1 national forest timber sale last Wednesday, according to the forest service.
His bids were \$75.15 per thousand for 1,900,000 board feet of Ponderosa pine, \$72.70 for 960,000 sugar pine, \$36.15 for 1,000,000 Douglas - fir, \$5.85 for 250,000 incense cedar and other species. The forest service appraised and advertised price was \$151,426.50.
Biden said he doesn't plan to log the timber until next winter. He considers the area

located at his "back door," to be favorable to logging operations since it is on flat, pumpkin ground that can be operated in any weather.
Runner-Up
McGrew Brothers Lumber company of Medford was runner-up for the sale, with other bidders including Double Dee Lumber company, Austin King, Steve Wilson, Ross Lumber company, Kogap Manufacturing company, Medford Corp., Timber Products, Inc., and Red Blanket Lumber company.
Ross Lumber company of Medford, with mills at White City and Prospect, was awarded the Prospect Flat Select 2 sale. The total bid on the 3,800,000 board feet was \$223,800, compared to the forest service appraisal of \$138,215.00.
Second place bidder for the sale was the McGrew Brothers Lumber company. Other bidders were Austin King, Double Dee Lumber company, Medford Corporation, Timber Products, Inc., Kogap Manufacturing company and Steve Wilson.
