The Frog lake road is closed and the lake covered with ice. The road is open to East and Paulina lakes but camping and parking areas will be extremely limited. Paulina is free of ice but East lake at mid-week had open water only near the resort and Warm Springs. Both are expected to be good on single eggs and worms.

South Century drive is open to Elk lake although only pickups and four-wheel drive vehicles are recommended beyond Lava lake.

Roads to North and South Twin lakes are open and in good condition.

Boat landings and campgrounds are open and accessible at Crane Prairie.

South Century drive via Deschutes bridge into Big Lava lake is plowed open but there are several bad mud holes. House trailers should be left at Deschutes bridge. Campground at Big Lava is practically free of snow. Elk lake is accessible from South Century drive but road is rough. Devils, Sparks, Todd and Three Creeks lakes inaccessible because of snow.

North Century drive open only as far as Bachelor ski area. Davis lake free of ice, roads from Wickiup reservoir, town of Crescent, and from near Highway 59 cafe to Davis lake open. Pelton reservoir should be good. Ochoco is very good.

Coastal streams do not open until May 28.

Elsewhere, the commission said, fishing should be fair to good. Many streams have been stocked. Chinook angling on the coast is only poor to fair.

Oregon's Prep Athlete of Year To Be Named

First annual KOIN Radio Oregon high school athlete of the year award named its climax this past week as the Board of Judges picked six finalists from the 33 nominations received from schools in every corner of the state.

The new annual competition, started by KOIN Sportscaster Johnny Carpenter, is an attempt to find the most outstanding Oregon high school athlete from the standpoint of athletic achievement, scholastic standing and extra-curricular or citizenship activities.

As Carpenter puts it: "This KOIN Radio award is designed to do away, once and for all, with the 'dumb athlete' fallacy." And the judges are ready to agree, expressing their honest amazement at the remarkable caliber of the 33 young men and women nominated by their schools for the award.

The athlete of the year will be selected from among the six finalists this coming week end. And permanent trophies will be presented to both the athlete and the school which he or she represents.

Serving as judges for this first annual award are: Ed Buck, superintendent of schools at Junction City; Clyde Beard, principal of The Dalles high school; Henry Kuchera, veteran coach at South Eugene High school; Gene Freese, athletic director at Beaverton and Sunset High schools and president of the Oregon High School Coaches association; Jack Patena, executive of Oregon football star and National Football League with Baltimore, Chicago Cardinals and now with Dallas; and James J. Richardson, long-time sports figure.
