**Wall Street Chatter**

New York—UPB—Suppose that the stock market is still on the high side, and you're uneasy about being heavily invested in common stocks. At the same time, you're not at all sure the bull market is over for good.

Princeton-Hall says that one way out of the dilemma is to shift 70-80 per cent of your investment into bonds and the remainder in fast-moving warrants.

If, contrary to your expectations, the market rises, the 20 per cent or more invested in warrants could show almost as much capital gain as if you had kept all your funds in common stocks.

On the other hand, P-H points out, if the market drops, the loss on your warrants can be limited, and will be offset by some gains in your bonds.

Dean Witter & Co. has a list of "brand name" companies which can be purchased at attractive levels in relation to their current earnings, dividends and prospects. They are: California Packing, Campbell Soup, National Biscuit, National Dairy and Swift & Co.

One issue that seems to have been ignored in the hunt for growth stocks, according to Bache & Co., is Briggs & Stratton. Considering its strong growth record and a yield of almost 5 per cent, the stock seems distinctly undervalued, Bache believes.
