

Brothers Arrested for Taking Own Property

Eric, Pa. — Three brothers were held as burglars for making off with a truck, boat and trailer owned by one of them.

Police explained that Gene McLaughlin, 30, of Denver, Colorado, towed his boat into a parking lot and left it parked there when he was called out of town unexpectedly.

When he returned, accompanied by his brothers, John and Lyle, he learned police had hauled everything off to a garage. The brothers broke into the garage, police said, and drove off with Gene's property. They were halted heading west out of the city.

Heidelberg Office Nerve Center of U.S. European Army

Heidelberg, Germany — The building looks like the home of a middle class businessman, or perhaps the suburban office of an insurance company.

It stands back from one of the main streets of this historic central German city, surrounded by flower beds.

Only the military policeman at the door indicates that it is the headquarters of the U.S. Army in Europe and the nerve center of the strongest peace-time army the United States ever has assembled.

Under the same roof, too, German, French and American officers man the command post which in time of war would blossom into the North Atlantic Treaty Organization's central army and group headquarters.

Stated simply by Gen. Clyde D. Eddleman, the job of the U.S. Army in Europe is "to stop any Soviet aggression across the Iron Curtain and make sure that the frontiers of the Free World remain right where they are now."

As the Army's ranking general in Europe, Eddleman commands troops stretched all the way from Leghorn, Italy, to Bordeaux, France. But the key unit of the forces he commands sits right alongside the Iron Curtain.

It is the U.S. Seventh Army, headquartered at Stuttgart and claimed by its commander, Lt. Gen. Francis W. Farrell, to be "the most powerful ground force the United States ever has put into the field."

State Bargaining For Tenants at Boardman Site

Salem — The governor's advisory committee to the Department of Planning and Development, feeling assured that the transfer with the federal government for the Boardman bombing range will be approved, is proceeding with bargaining for tenants for the giant Boardman site.

The state seeks to turn the 60,000 acre bombing range into a land age industrial park.

The space trade is contained in a bill passed by both houses of Congress. The bill is now in the hands of a joint conference committee and state officials said today they expect "no difficulty" in final passage.

Signing of an industrial firm or firms for the Boardman site is expected to coincide with final approval of the property trade with the U.S. government. The state is trading the Lake county property in Oregon for a Navy bombing range at Boardman in Lake county.

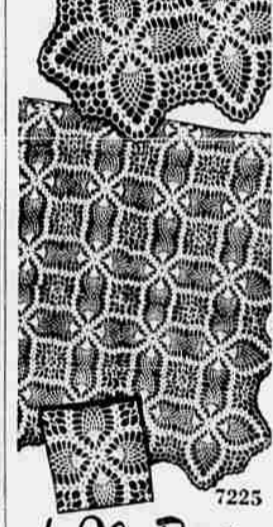
