

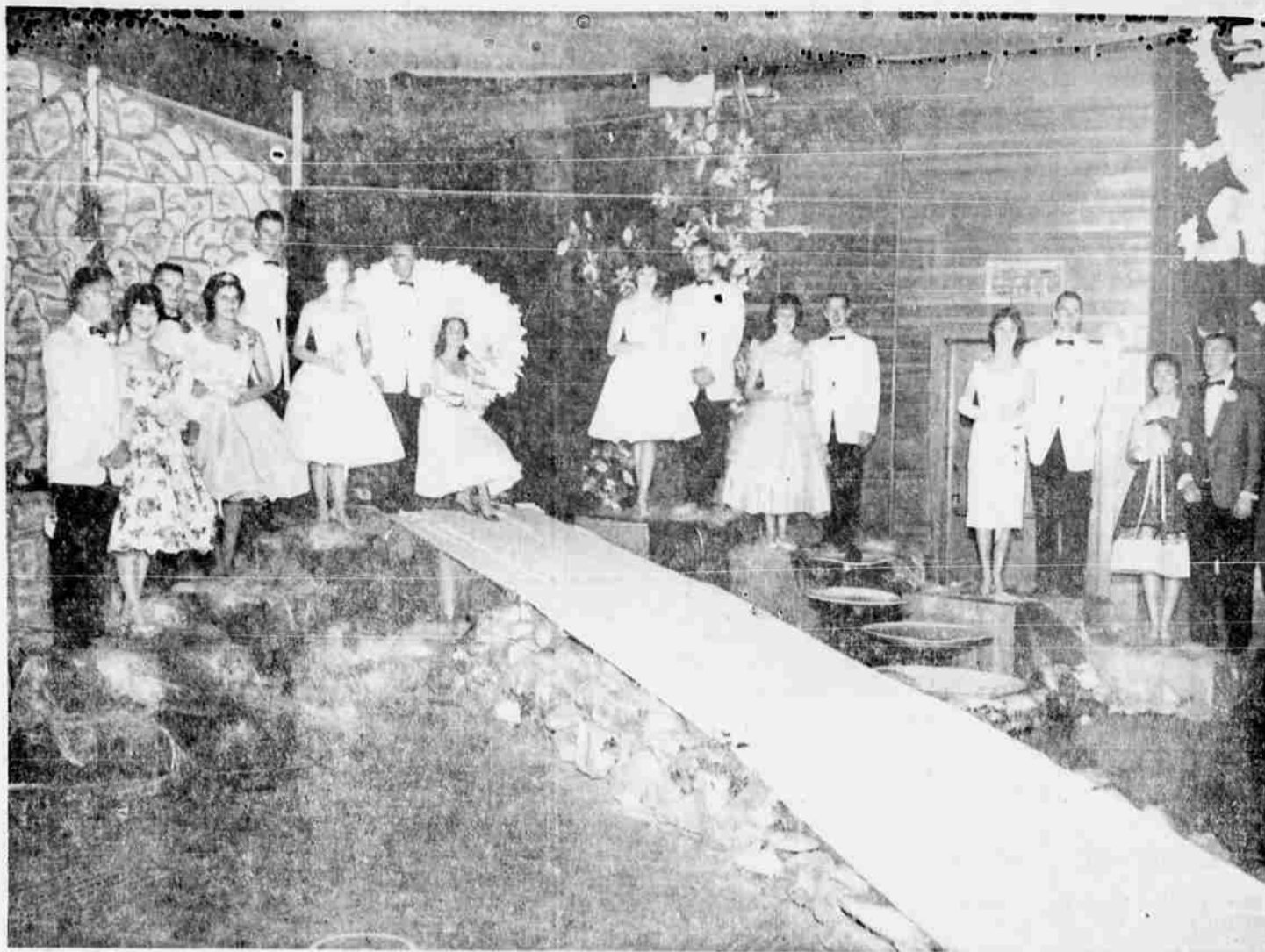
# Prom Time
