## Summer Employment Program For Teen-Agers Is Planned

Jackson county teen-agers, thanks largely to the efforts of a state official, two Ashland businessmen and a young Medford man named Fred Stock, now will be able to take advantage of this area's first summer employment program.

### Innocent Pleas Entered in Case

Pleas of innocent were entered in district court Thursday by the attorney of two persons charged with possessing, displaying, and operating a game of chance.

Warren Lessee, Medford lawyer, entered the pleas for Eugene Winifred Morgan, an employee of North Riverside Tavern, and Warren Eugene Greb, an employee of Foss' Billiards.

Warrants were issued for the two employees after city police confiscated one pinball machine from each of the businesses Tuesday after police reported that an officer received money for free games won.

Bail was set at \$150 each by Judge Roy Bashaw. Trial date for Eugene W. Morgan was set for May 31 at 9:30 a.m. and for Greb on June 2 at 8:30 a.m.

### Bonneville Power Funds Approved

Washington-AP—The House Appropriations Committee today approved the full administration request of \$18,720,000 for construction of new transmission facilities by the Bonneville Power Administration.

Both full and part-time employment will be available. Jobs are expected to range from baby-sitting and yardwork to fulltime employment with local business firms.

All boys and girls in the county between the ages of 14 and 18 are eligible to apply for work. Employers may be business firms or individuals.

### Tabernacle to Build Station

Ashland - A construction permit for the Faith Tabernacle, Ashland, to build a 1,000-watt daytime radio station was approved Wednesday by the federal communications commission, the Rev. Leo Wine, minister of the church, reported that he had been informed this week.

The station, to be built at the church and on four adjoining acres, will broadcast religious music and programs and news on 1350 kilocycles.

The station will be operated on a commercial basis owned and operated by the non-profit corporation, Faith Tabernacle church. The studios will be built inside the present church building, Mr. Wine said, with the 185-foot transmitter tower to be constructed on the adjoining property.

Construction will start immediately, he said, with tentative plans for broadcasting to begin in September. The station is expected to cost approximately \$25,000. It will employ four persons and have Associated Press newswire.

Application for the station was filed by Faith Tabernacle Inc., in September, 1958.

Standard Applications

Prospective employees will fill out standard job application forms furnished by the employment service. Information needed will include the applicant's name, age, address, telephone number, type of job wanted, hours available and experience.

Monday, June 20, at 5 p.m. is the filing deadline for job applicants. Employers may call any time during the summer.

Prospective employers may file by calling the employment service at Spring 2-5297 or the drug store at MURdock 9-8111, whichever is pertinent. They must list what type of jobs they have to offer and any special experience they expect of their employees.

Work permits, when required, will be furnished by the employment service.

Employee applications will be filed according to job preferences and every effort will be made to see that there

is equal distribution of assignments. Hours which teen-agers are able to work will be taken into consideration.

Operate in Summer

The program will operate throughout the summer. Employers need only call either of the two clearing houses during standard working hours Monday through Friday. If an employer wants the services of a particular youth who has worked for him previously, the employment service or drug store will attempt to contact the teen-ager concerned. If he or she is not available, another individual will be contacted.

Stock said he wishes to emphasize that the program is open to both boys and girls, and stressed that the word "employers" includes not only business firms but private individuals who wish to hire youth for such chores as baby-sitting and yard work.

"I believe youths in Jackson county will support the program," Stock said, "because they never have had

such an opportunity, even though they often have expressed a desire for it."

Mrs. Ila Summerow, Ashland, is seeking \$1,818.10 in special damages and \$14,800 in general damages from Dr. C. I. Drummond, Jackson county public health officer, as a result of an accident Dec. 29, 1959, according to a complaint on file in the Jackson county clerk's office.

The complaint may be amended at a later date for additional expenses, it was stated.

The accident occurred on East Main st. between Riverside ave. and Bear Creek bridge, according to the complaint. Mrs. Summerow charges she was struck by a car driven by Dr. Drummond as she was crossing East Main st. Mrs. Summerow charges

that Dr. Drummond was negligent since he failed to stop his car at the crosswalk, drove at a speed greater than reasonable and prudent, and failed to keep the car under control.
