**'Placebo Diagnoses'**

Every week I get letters from women who perhaps admit that their good old family doctor for years has been telling them that their illness is all due to nervousness and perhaps much a nuisance and strain at home. But the woman never did like this diagnosis. She thought her doctor was a bit old-fashioned, and so she started going from doctor to doctor, trying to find one who would diagnose a disease she could be proud of. Most of these doctors, after examining her with many tests, said they couldn't find anything wrong. Eventually, a woman like this finds a busy doctor who has decided that the only way in which he can practice with any speed and comfort is to give these women what I call a "placebo diagnosis." Placebo means "I will please," by giving the woman what she wants. Just now, one of my secretaries handed me a letter from one of these women who says she eventually found a doctor who delighted her, but also scared the life out of her. He gave her the impression that all the doctors she had seen previously had "missed the boat," what she had "the worse case of visceroposis that he had ever seen."

**Confidence Lost**

With this, the poor woman is now all in pieces; she has lost confidence in the medical profession, and she wonders what can be done to cure the "visceroposis." This word implies that her abdominal organs have fallen down below the position where we doctors—back before 1910—used to think they belonged. I wish I could sit down with this unhappy lady and explain to her that back around 1919 we doctors began to get x-ray machines powerful enough so that in a dark room we could see a patient's stomach and bowel while he or she was standing up back of a screen. This is the all-important point. For the first time in history, someone could see a human stomach and bowel in a person standing up. Before that, we had seen the stomach and bowel only in persons lying down, either dead or on an operating table. We hadn't known that when people stand up, the abdominal organs tend to float downward six or 12 inches or more. When I first saw this, I was surprised; but when I saw that so-called visceroposis appeared in almost all thin people, I soon lost interest in the phenomenon.

When I found it in hundreds of healthy young athletes with a good digestion, I knew it was not a cause of disease. During my 25 years at Mayo's, I never once saw our x-ray men pay an attention to it. But although some of us doctors kept warning our fellows not to pay any attention to a natural and harmless phenomenon, for years surgeons operated for "ptosis" (until they got fed-up with the poor results), and many doctors ordered special corsets for their women patients. They had them sleep at night in a bed the foot of which was raised 10 inches or so!

**Report Promised On Downed Fliers**

Berlin—(UPI)—A Soviet spokesman said Monday a statement will be issued "soon" on the U. S. Army transport plane forced down Friday by Soviet fighters. He hinted the nine Americans aboard may be turned over to the East Germans.

The Soviet statement presumably would answer an American request for release of the eight men and woman whose plane strayed into East Germany and was forced down by six Soviet jet fighters.

The spokesman said he did not know if the Americans "still are in Soviet hands"—an indication they may have been turned over to the East Germans. Such a move could lead to a long period of imprisonment and an East-West diplomatic wrangle over their release.
