Large Fish Released In Rogue

Forty thousand large rainbow trout were released last week to streams of the Rogue basin by Oregon state game commission liberation crews in preparation for the opening of trout season this Saturday. The fish are averaging three per pound, or 9.5 inches in length.

The big rainbow were planted in the north fork of the Rogue from above Foster creek forest camp down to Woodruff bridge, in the south and middle forks of Rogue river at the Prospect-Butte Falls road crossings, in Big Butte creek above and opposite the hatchery down to Cobleigh bridge, in Little Butte creek from Lake creek down to the Eagle Point Irrigation district screen, and at many points along the Upper Rogue from Laurelhurst bridge down to Bybee bridge.

Waters released in the middle section of the Rogue were at Gold Ray, Sams creek, Gold Hill, Rogue River, Pierce riffle, Greens creek, Grants Pass state park, Weston riffle and Matson park.

The Applegate river system received fish from above Copper down to McKee bridge and in Carberry creek up to Sturgis camp. The Illinois system was hit on Sucker creek from the mouth of Cave creek down through Gray-back Forest Camp, and the main river at the "forks" hole in back of Redwood ranger station.

A total of 71,000 were allocated for liberation in May, but because the rainbow grew to larger sizes than expected, time would only allow the release of 40,000 before the Saturday, May 28, opening. The balance of the May allocation will be put out during the first week in June when the plants that were skipped this past week will be planted and sprinkle-type releases will be made in those locations receiving heavy fishing pressure the opening week end.

A total of 135,000 of these large rainbow have been raised at the Butte Falls hatchery for release to the Rogue watershed in the 1960 season. In addition to the balance of the May allocation, 41,000 are scheduled for June, and 23,000 more for July.

Tots Will Get Attention in Swim Classes

YMCA swimming for boys and girls from 6 to 16 years of age will start on Monday, June 13, with David E. Curson, Y physical director as instructor.

Special attention will be given to classes for tots, those ages 6 and 7. There are openings for 120 beginners with two lessons per week for each section. These sections will meet Monday and Thursday, Tuesday and Friday or Wednesday and Saturday at 9 a.m. Classes will be limited to 20 enrollees and reservations may be made at the Y.

Curson will work directly with the students, giving special attention to those having difficulty with beginners' skills. A section on advanced swimming is held for tots who have passed the beginning level.

The physical director has just returned from the northwest area Y aquatic institute at Portland. He studied and practiced new techniques. Highlight of the institute concerned teaching of beginners.

With the new pool acoustical treatment and heating plant operation handicaps which plagued former classes have been eliminated, Robert Jones, Y general secretary has declared. He said that the swim instruction service means much to the safety and health of youth in the community. Each year more than 700 swimmers have passed the beginners test, he said. United Medford Crusade bears part of the expense of this service.

Big Game Rule Hearing Friday

Portland — (AP) — The state game commission meets here Friday to discuss big game hunting regulations for the 1960 season.

Rules for hunting deer, elk and antelope will be discussed and regulations will be tentatively set. After a two-week interval the commission will meet June 10 at which final regulations will be adopted. The commission invited the public to attend.
