

U.S. Must Hold To Ways of Honor, Johnson Declares

Oklahoma City, Okla. (UPI)—Senate Democratic Leader Lyndon B. Johnson says the United States must "hold to ways of honor" and avoid a "cloak and dagger America" in its cold war with Russia.

The Texas Democrat, an active but unannounced Presidential contender, offered what sounded like criticism of this country's role in the recent U2 spy plane incident.

"When adversaries struggle in combat, there is always the temptation to adopt the rules and the ways of the aggressor — and, in so doing, the defender loses more of honor than he can gain in victory," Johnson said in a speech at Oklahoma City University.

"We have traveled far down the road of imitation in these years of the cold war," he added. "Free men must no longer allow the tyrant to set their standards for them. We must hold to ways of honor — we must preserve the Democratic life — for what small free men have gained if they win the peace but lose their souls?"

He added: "We don't want a cloak and dagger America. We don't want to be molded into the image of an aggressor nation."

Johnson urged the West to fashion the structures supporting the mutual security program "into a new concept of mutual opportunity."

"We should enlarge the community of free men the world over — from North Atlantic and Latin America and from the growing suburbs of Africa and Asia," he said. He said America "cannot speak of peace without speaking of opportunity."

The Democratic leader said the lesson of past "bitter experiences" is that "the initiative for any summit conference must be the initiative of all free nations of free men."

"Great Powers can speak only for themselves, he said. The big powers which failed to agree in Paris last week, he added, "did not carry in their pockets the proxies of all the human race."

Court Approves Five of Eight New Traffic Rules

Salem (UPI)—Five of eight new traffic court rules proposed by the traffic court rules committee have been approved by the State Supreme court.

The high court recommended for further study those authorizing application of criminal statutory procedures in traffic cases, promulgation of local rules of procedure by each magistrate or judge and amendment of traffic citations or complaints after trial to conform to the proof as adduced during the trial.

Those approved and which will be effective next July 1 include:

—A uniform traffic citation and complaint, formerly the "traffic ticket."

—Definition of scope, purpose and construction of the rules to provide just determination of traffic offenses.

—Penalty of criminal contempt of court for any person "fixing" or attempting to "fix" a traffic citation or complaint.

—Trial of traffic cases to be conducted separately from other cases by hearing either by a division of the court at a traffic session or upon designation of a particular time.

—Traffic cases to be conducted pursuant to the state Bar canons of ethics.

An actual ninth recommendation approved was the July 1 effective date.
