

Number of Doctors In U. S. Increases

Chicago (Science Service)—The number of physicians in the U. S. and its possessions increased by about 4,800 last year, the Council on Medical Education and Hospitals of the American Medical Association reports here.

The 1959 report, as compared with 1958 figures, shows increases in 29 states. The total number of additions to the medical profession last year was 8,209, including 1,626 who were foreign-trained. Approximately 3,500 physicians died. The council's complete report appears in the current issue of The Journal of the American Medical Association.
