Small Worlds Around Us

There was ever such a thing as a perfect "mix-master" then these glands are the original, and really fool-proof progenitors of such machines. Cows and sheep have "head-sets" called horns, these are merely tresses of hair held together by some other variety of "body-glue". These glands are somewhat different from those in the legs. Some sets make horns, others make hooves.

The deer family "horns in" on another angle and complicates the already confused gland idea a little by coming up with something different. The horns of the deer are not held together with glue, but real, honest to goodness bone. They are attached to the animal's skeleton and each year they are shed.

The horns and hooves of cattle and sheep, the fingernails of man, the claws of dogs and bears grow constantly and must be trimmed or worn down by constant use. Fingernails, claws and hooves are not connected in any way to the skeleton of the owner.

All these tresses or nails or hair are useful. The fingernails serve many purposes. In primitive man they were handy in ripping the husks from food or the skin from animals. They served them, as they do now, as tweezers, forceps, screw-drivers, probes, scoops and small cutting tools.

Modern man also finds many small uses. His toe nails, however, are just going along for the ride. The bare-foot boy of course finds them handy to run slivers under, or he can watch them turn a deep blue-black when his toe is stubbed on a rock. The boy too, finds a limited use for toe nails. He can use the nail on one big toe to dig at an itch on the other leg.

Cows, sheep and allied animals also have these clever little "mixers" in the lower limbs. The rhinoceros, determined to be disgustingly different, has his "mixing gadgets" in his homely nose. If

SECTION 1. That it is the intention of the City Council of the said city to cause a ten (10) inch water main to be laid in Juniper Way from Mira Mar Avenue to Murphy Road and to assess the cost of said water main on the property fronting on said street (in proportion to the frontage of said property).
SECTION 2. Resolution to be noted for a period of ten days prior to said meeting in five public and conspicuous places in the said city.)
SECTION 3. That warrants for the costs of the aforementioned improvement shall bear interest at 4% per annum and shall constitute a lien in favor of the City of Medford, Oregon, and said warrants shall be issued pursuant to and in accordance with the provisions set forth in ORS 267.302 to 267.310 inclusive.
