trist in a downtown office. As Dr. Schmideberg says, offenders and criminals and their families rarely have any money. Worse yet, in this whole country there are very few psychiatrists who have worked around police courts long enough to get any practical experience in the handling of surlily delinquent. No one can hope to influence a sullen, hostile, arrogant and suspicious criminal unless he is a man of outstanding character with much natural charm and much knowledge of the criminal mind.

Dr. G. N. Thompson, of Los Angeles, wrote a book on these people. After spending much of his life trying to help them in the courts of Los Angeles, he wound up, doubting if anyone could make over a psychopathic delinquent. Dr. Hervey Cleckley, of Augusta, Ga., who once wrote a magnificent book on psychopathic delinquents (The Mask of Sanity) also wound up feeling hopeless about these people. Some delinquents, of course, can be helped if they are sane and have a good intelligence, and if they get into mischief only because of running around with a wild gang. Certainly, society hasn't yet tackled intelligently the terrible problem of psychopathic delinquency. Probably all we will do in the next 50 years will be to spend large sums on surveys, the report of which will never be read or used. The worst surveys are those made by people who, before they start, have read Freud, and hence already know all the answers. Because of the many blind spots Freudians have, many of them can see only what they fully expected to see. For instance; it would never occur to one of them to ask the mother of a psychopathically delinquent son what his immediate ancestors and uncles and aunts were like. Today, any study of the heredity of these lads cannot be made.
