### Too Many Transfusions

At a recent meeting in Atlanta a Harvard professor of surgery, Dr. Carl W. Walter, complained that today too many transfusions of blood are being given. He said that nowadays more people die of transfusions than of appendicitis. The deaths are bad enough, but one knows how many more hundreds of people there are who, after having been given a blood transfusion - of doubtful necessity - later, after from two to six months, came down with a dangerous attack of hepatitis. No one is ever going to give me a transfusion unless, at the time, the need for it is very great.
