

Congress Studies Methods To Amend Taft-Hartley Labor Law

Editor's note: The following article was written by a June graduate of the school of journalism at the University of Oregon as an "editorial summary" of the conclusions developed in the thesis required of each graduate. The opinions are those of the writer.

Early in 1947, in reaction to a series of nation-wide strikes in major industries, a Congressional investigation of labor and labor practices and general public opinion, Congress was engaged in hammering out a new labor law. Finally, several bills were submitted to Congress, varying in severity in dealing with the labor situation, but all designed to amend the Wagner Act of 1935, which had been the prevailing labor law of the land. By June of 1947, Congress had narrowed its sights to one bill submitted to their respective houses by Sen. Robert A. Taft and Rep. Fred A. Hartley. With the attention of the country focused on its action, Congress, after lengthy debate, passed the bill.

The nation then elected President Truman who was known to be violently opposed to the Taft-Hartley measure. In his veto message, read to the House on June 20, the President declared that Taft-Hartley "would be a dangerous stride in the direction of a totally managed economy. It contains seeds of discord which would plague this nation for years to come."

Despite this prediction, Congress passed the law over the President's veto. What of the Taft-Hartley Act today? Its provisions certainly have not had the dire results expected by President Truman or by labor and its supporters. As a result, much of the original bitterness over the law has worn away. However, in time of labor-management crisis, such as in the steel strike of 1959, the Taft-Hartley Act is prominently back in the news once more. And then talk of amendment is heard.

As a result of these occasional nationwide strikes, probably the best known provision of Taft-Hartley is the national emergency clause which includes the 80-day injunction as part of its six-step procedure. The powers granted to the President under this emergency clause have been used 17 times since 1947, 14 of which included the injunction provision. Nine of the strikes requiring the injunction were settled during the 80-day injunction period. Five strikes were settled after the whole set of emergency provisions had been exhausted and the injunction had expired.

The debate over changing the law has included vehement demands for repeal, and almost every section, at one time or another, has been considered for a complete overhaul by the amending process. Most of these efforts, though, have failed.

Amendments Introduced The most recent attempt to amend Taft-Hartley came late in 1959. Three proposed amendments were introduced into Congress at this time. Of the three, the Landrum-Griffin bill was passed. The portions of this bill affecting Taft-Hartley tightened the restrictions against secondary boycotts, clarified the government's role and jurisdiction over labor disputes and made a few changes in union elections during strikes. Landrum-Griffin also repealed a non-communist affidavit clause, in which Taft-Hartley required union officials to sign an oath stating they had never been Communists. This oath had proved totally ineffective.

Although Landrum-Griffin helped tighten and clarify certain loopholes in Taft-Hartley, it still ignored many important areas, including the national emergency provisions. But any future amending is likely to create as great a storm of protest and controversy as surrounded the passage of Taft-Hartley itself. Congress appears to be divided over the direction any additional legislation should take.

There are three alternatives open. One would be to leave Taft-Hartley as it is. Few are agreed that this is the right step. However, as in the past, no one side may be able to gather enough support to push its measures through Congress. Another alternative would be to strengthen Taft-Hartley by broadening and deepening the right of the government to intervene in labor-management affairs. Several noted economists feel that this may take the form of a compulsory arbitration law. This is an extreme of government intervention and is often found in socialized and collectivized economies.

A third alternative would be to weaken Taft-Hartley, allowing labor and management more freedom in the conduct of their affairs. Thus, the two groups would be forced to accept the responsibility of maintaining good labor relations and of proving to the legislators as well as the rest of the country that they deserve this responsibility.

Committee Appointed In November, 1959, Congress appointed a committee, headed by Prof. Archibald Cox of the Harvard University law school, to look into the problem of labor legislation and the direction it should take. Until this investigation is completed, little action in this area will be taken.

However, when the findings of the committee are made known, we can expect Taft-Hartley to be in the news and in the center of controversy again. At this time the public should again be watchful of the actions of Congress. Its decisions will profoundly affect us all.
